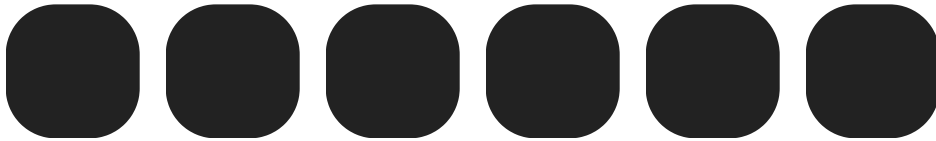

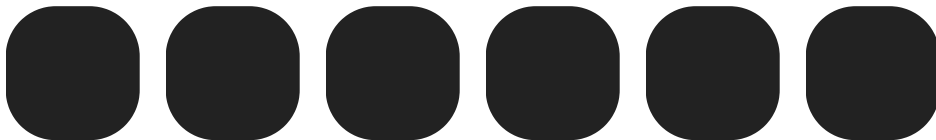

After working up quite the appetite, the veterans wanted nothing more than to devour their catch of the day!!

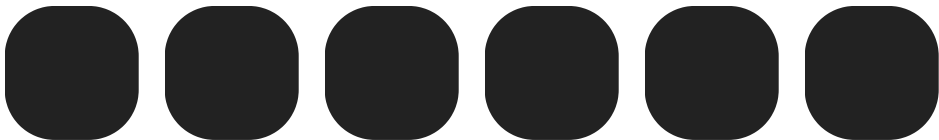
