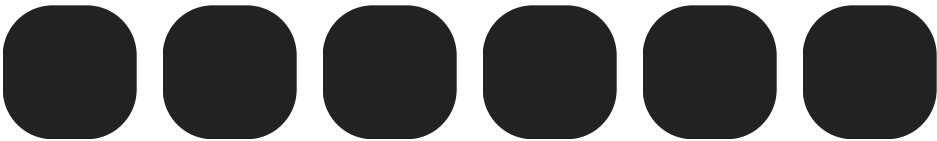
The couple reside in St. Charles, Missouri.
