Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a Special Weather Statement for Stoddard County, MO.

I ...WINTRY MIX OF PRECIPITATION POSSIBLE THIS WEEKEND

... A STORM SYSTEM OVER THE SOUTHERN STATES WILL SPREAD PRECIPITATION NORTHWARD, POSSIBLY REACHING AS FAR NORTH AS THE OHIO RIVER AND PORTIONS OF SOUTHEAST MISSOURI.

THE HIGHEST POTENTIAL FOR MEASURABLE SNOW OR ICE WILL BE IN THE TENNESSEE BORDER COUNTIES OF WESTERN KENTUCKY.

THERE IS A CHANCE OF SOME LIGHT ACCUMULATIONS AS FAR NORTH AS THE CITIES OF OWENSBORO, PADUCAH, AND POPLAR BLUFF. PRECIPITATION MAY REACH PORTIONS OF THE REGION ON SATURDAY, BUT TEMPERATURES WILL BE MAINLY ABOVE FREEZING IN THE AFTERNOON.

THE PRIMARY TIME PERIOD OF CONCERN IS SATURDAY NIGHT, WHEN TEMPERATURES WILL FALL TO AROUND 30 DEGREES. PRECIPITATION WILL DIMINISH OR END ON SUNDAY MORNING.

PRECIPITATION AMOUNTS ARE FORECAST TO BE HEAVIEST IN THE SOUTHERNMOST COUNTIES OF WESTERN KENTUCKY, WHERE AN INCH OR TWO OF SLEET AND SNOW IS POSSIBLE. BE READY TO ALTER YOUR TRAVEL PLANS AS CONDITIONS DICTATE.

Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service has issued a Special Weather Statement for Stoddard County, Missouri.

...POTENTIAL FOR SIGNIFICANT WINTER PRECIPITATION EXISTS THIS WEEKEND

... SOME WINTRY PRECIPITATION IS EXPECTED THIS WEEKEND.

THE HEAVIEST PRECIPITATION POTENTIAL IS SATURDAY NIGHT.

DEPENDING ON THE EXACT TRACK OF THE STORM SYSTEM, SIGNIFICANT IMPACTS ARE POSSIBLE IN SOUTHWEST KENTUCKY AND SOUTHEAST MISSOURI. AT THIS TIME, MOSTLY SLEET AND SNOW ARE FORECAST, BUT SOME LIGHT ICING IS POSSIBLE.

THE PRECIPITATION WILL BE SLOW TO GET STARTED VERY LATE FRIDAY NIGHT AND SATURDAY. MANY AREAS WILL REMAIN DRY UNTIL SATURDAY NIGHT, ESPECIALLY THOSE AREAS NORTH OF A CAPE GIRARDEAU TO PADUCAH TO HOPKINSVILLE KENTUCKY LINE.

STEADIER AND MORE WIDESPREAD PRECIPITATION IS FORECAST SATURDAY NIGHT.

THERE WILL BE A SHARP NORTHERN EDGE TO THE PRECIPITATION SHIELD, AND THE INTERSTATE 64 CORRIDOR IN SOUTHERN ILLINOIS AND SOUTHWEST INDIANA COULD STAY DRY. FURTHER SOUTH, SIGNIFICANT SNOW AND SLEET ACCUMULATIONS ARE POSSIBLE ACROSS SOUTHWEST

KENTUCKY AND SOUTHEAST MISSOURI. THE PRECIPITATION WILL DIMINISH ON SUNDAY, WHEN SOME ADDITIONAL LIGHT ACCUMULATIONS ARE POSSIBLE.

... * WHAT...HEAVY MIXED PRECIPITATION POSSIBLE.

TOTAL SNOW ACCUMULATIONS OF 2 TO 5 INCHES AND ICE ACCUMULATIONS OF AROUND ONE TENTH OF AN INCH POSSIBLE. * WHERE...PORTIONS OF SOUTHWEST INDIANA, SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, WESTERN KENTUCKY AND SOUTHERN ILLINOIS.

THE HIGHEST SNOW ACCUMULATIONS EXPECTED OVER PARTS OF SOUTHERN ILLINOIS, SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, AND PART OF THE PURCHASE AREA OF WEST KENTUCKY. Special Weather Statement for Stoddard County

Stoddard County, Missouri - Special Weather Statement issued by the National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky.

...ICE AND SNOW POSSIBLE THIS EVENING.

... A WINTRY MIX OF PRECIPITATION CAN BE EXPECTED TO SLOWLY WORK SOUTHEAST ACROSS PARTS OF THE QUAD STATE REGION,

PERSISTING INTO THE EVENING AND OVERNIGHT HOURS. THE VAST MAJORITY OF THE REGION WILL SEE JUST RAIN THROUGH SUNSET WITH TEMPERATURES IN THE LOWER 40S. BUT SOME LOCATIONS IN SOUTHEAST MISSOURI AND SOUTHWEST ILLINOIS COULD SEE PATCHY SLEET OCCUR ON THE LEADING EDGE OF THE RAIN.

AS TEMPERATURES FALL AFTER SUNSET, THE RAIN WILL GRADUALLY MIX WITH THEN CHANGE OVER TO SLEET, FREEZING RAIN AND SNOW DURING THE EVENING HOURS. THIS IS ESPECIALLY TRUE FOR SOUTHEAST MISSOURI AND SOUTHWEST ILLINOIS.

THE BEST CHANCE FOR SEEING ANY ACCUMULATING SLEET AND SNOW THIS EVENING WILL BE ALONG AND NORTH OF A LINE OF PIEDMONT AND PERRYVILLE MISSOURI, ONWARD TO AVA, DUQUOIN, MOUNT VERNON, AND CISNE ILLINOIS. SNOWFALL AMOUNTS COULD RANGE FROM ONE TO THREE TENTHS BEFORE THE PRECIPITATION ENDS OVERNIGHT.

IN ADDITION TO THE SNOW AND SLEET, UP TO A TENTH OF AN INCH OF ICE MAY ACCUMULATE ON ELEVATED SURFACES ALONG AND NORTHWEST OF A LINE FROM PIEDMONT TO MARBLE HILL AND PERRYVILLE MISSOURI. THE COLDEST AIR WILL RESIDE ALONG THE FOOT HILLS OF SOUTHEAST MISSOURI AND PARTS OF SOUTHWEST ILLINOIS THROUGH MIDNIGHT, BEFORE WORKING SOUTHEAST TO THE OHIO AND WABASH RIVERS BY 3 AM CST.

PATCHES OF LIGHT FREEZING RAIN WILL BE POSSIBLE OVER SOUTHERN ILLINOIS AND THE REMAINDER OF SOUTHEAST MISSOURI DURING THIS TIME. HOWEVER, AS THE FREEZING AIR MOVES IN, MOST OF THE MEASURABLE PRECIPITATION WILL BE EXITING THE AREA OVERNIGHT. VERY LITTLE, IF ANY FREEZING RAIN ACCUMULATION IS EXPECTED. AS TEMPERATURES FALL INTO THE MIDDLE AND UPPER 20S OVERNIGHT, ANY PRECIPITATION LEFT ON UNTREATED ROADS AND BRIDGES WILL FREEZE AND MAY BECOME SLICK AND HAZARDOUS.

FOR THOSE TRAVELING IN SOUTHEAST MISSOURI AND SOUTHERN ILLINOIS LATE TONIGHT OR EARLY TUESDAY, BE WATCHFUL FOR BLACK ICE AND EXERCISE CAUTION WHILE DRIVING.

ANOTHER WINTER SYSTEM IS SLATED TO RETURN TO THE QUAD STATE REGION WEDNESDAY NIGHT INTO THURSDAY, SO TRAVELERS AND RESIDENTS SHOULD TAKE MEASURES TO PREPARE FOR MORE WINTRY WEATHER LATER THIS WEEK.

THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A * FLASH FLOOD WATCH FOR ALL OF SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, SOUTHERN ILLINOIS, SOUTHWEST INDIANA, AND PORTIONS OF WESTERN KENTUCKY, INCLUDING THE COUNTIES OF BALLARD, CRITTENDEN, HENDERSON, LIVINGSTON, MCCRACKEN, UNION, AND WEBSTER. * FROM FRIDAY EVENING THROUGH SUNDAY MORNING

* INTERVALS OF SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS WITH HEAVY RAIN WILL ACCOMPANY THE REMNANTS OF TROPICAL STORM GORDON LATE THIS WEEK AND INTO THE WEEKEND.
