He was preceded in death by his father, Marvin Jones.

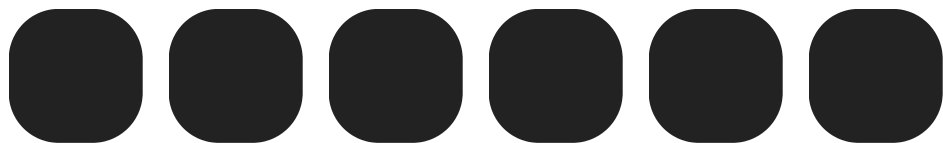
