Special Weather Statement Issued for Stoddard County

Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a Special Weather Statement for Stoddard County, Missouri until 6:45 p.m. tonight!

SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT UNTIL 6:45 PM CST MON ...GUSTY SOUTH WINDS EXPECTED ACROSS THE QUAD STATE TODAY...

AS THE DAY PROGRESSES, SOUTH WINDS 15 TO 25 MPH, WITH LOCAL WIND GUSTS TO 35 MPH WILL OVERSPREAD THE QUAD STATE REGION.

THESE BREEZY CONDITIONS WILL BE OCCURRING AHEAD OF AN INTENSE AREA OF LOW PRESSURE THAT IS EXPECTED TO MOVE FROM THE CENTRAL PLAINS TO LAKE MICHIGAN BY THIS EVENING. IF YOU HAVE OUTDOOR OBJECTS THAT ARE NOT SECURED, THEY MAY BE TOSSED AROUND BY THE WINDS. IF YOU DRIVE HIGH PROFILE VEHICLES, SUCH AS A TRACTOR TRAILER OR RECREATIONAL VEHICLE, YOU MAY ENCOUNTER SOME DIFFICULTY IN STEERING YOUR VEHICLE.

THIS WILL BE ESPECIALLY TRUE FOR THOSE TRAVELING ON ROADS ORIENTED EAST OR WEST TODAY. THE BREEZY WIND CONDITIONS SHOULD DROP OFF SIGNIFICANTLY AFTER SUNSET ACROSS THE REGION.

..WIND ADVISORY IN EFFECT FROM 3 AM THURSDAY TO 3 AM CST FRIDAY...

THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A WIND ADVISORY, WHICH IS IN EFFECT FROM 3 AM THURSDAY TO 3 AM CST FRIDAY.

* TIMING... LATE TONIGHT THROUGH THURSDAY, INTO THURSDAY NIGHT.

* WINDS... SUSTAINED WINDS INCREASE TO 20 TO 25 MPH WITH OCCASIONAL GUSTS TO 40 MPH POSSIBLE.

* IMPACTS...GUSTY WINDS CAN CAUSE TREE AND BRANCH DAMAGE.

LOOSE OUTDOOR OBJECTS MAY BE BLOWN AROUND.

VEHICULAR TRAFFIC, ESPECIALLY FOR HIGH PROFILE VEHICLES, WILL EXPERIENCE SOME DIFFICULTIES. PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...

...WINTRY MIX OF PRECIPITATION POSSIBLE THIS WEEKEND

... A STORM SYSTEM OVER THE SOUTHERN STATES WILL SPREAD WINTRY PRECIPITATION NORTHWARD LATE TONIGHT AND SATURDAY, POSSIBLY REACHING AS FAR NORTH AS PORTIONS OF SOUTHEAST MISSOURI AND WEST KENTUCKY.

THE HIGHEST POTENTIAL FOR MEASURABLE SNOW OR ICE WILL BE IN THE TENNESSEE BORDER COUNTIES OF WESTERN KENTUCKY, AND THE ARKANSAS BORDER COUNTIES OF MISSOURI. THERE IS A CHANCE OF SOME VERY LIGHT SNOW ACCUMULATIONS AS FAR NORTH AS THE CITIES OF MADISONVILLE KENTUCKY, PADUCAH, SIKESTON AND VAN BUREN

MISSOURI.

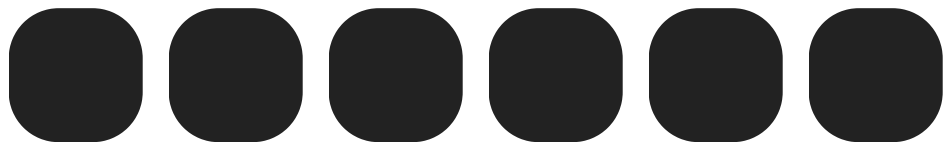

THERE IS A CHANCE OF SOME LIGHT ACCUMULATIONS AS FAR NORTH AS THE CITIES OF OWENSBORO, PADUCAH, AND POPLAR BLUFF. PRECIPITATION MAY REACH PORTIONS OF THE REGION ON SATURDAY, BUT TEMPERATURES WILL BE MAINLY ABOVE FREEZING IN THE AFTERNOON.

Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service has issued a Special Weather Statement for Stoddard County, Missouri.

...POTENTIAL FOR SIGNIFICANT WINTER PRECIPITATION EXISTS THIS WEEKEND

... SOME WINTRY PRECIPITATION IS EXPECTED THIS WEEKEND.

THE HEAVIEST PRECIPITATION POTENTIAL IS SATURDAY NIGHT.

DEPENDING ON THE EXACT TRACK OF THE STORM SYSTEM, SIGNIFICANT IMPACTS ARE POSSIBLE IN SOUTHWEST KENTUCKY AND SOUTHEAST MISSOURI. AT THIS TIME, MOSTLY SLEET AND SNOW ARE FORECAST, BUT SOME LIGHT ICING IS POSSIBLE.

THE PRECIPITATION WILL BE SLOW TO GET STARTED VERY LATE FRIDAY NIGHT AND SATURDAY. MANY AREAS WILL REMAIN DRY UNTIL SATURDAY NIGHT, ESPECIALLY THOSE AREAS NORTH OF A CAPE GIRARDEAU TO PADUCAH TO HOPKINSVILLE KENTUCKY LINE.

STEADIER AND MORE WIDESPREAD PRECIPITATION IS FORECAST SATURDAY NIGHT.

THERE WILL BE A SHARP NORTHERN EDGE TO THE PRECIPITATION SHIELD, AND THE INTERSTATE 64 CORRIDOR IN SOUTHERN ILLINOIS AND SOUTHWEST INDIANA COULD STAY DRY. FURTHER SOUTH, SIGNIFICANT SNOW AND SLEET ACCUMULATIONS ARE POSSIBLE ACROSS SOUTHWEST

KENTUCKY AND SOUTHEAST MISSOURI. THE PRECIPITATION WILL DIMINISH ON SUNDAY, WHEN SOME ADDITIONAL LIGHT ACCUMULATIONS ARE POSSIBLE.

WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY FROM 3PM CST WED UNTIL 6PM CST THU

...WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY IN EFFECT FROM 3 PM THIS AFTERNOON TO 6 PM CST THURSDAY...

* WHAT...SNOW, OCCASIONALLY MIXED WITH LIGHT FREEZING RAIN, WILL DEVELOP AND SPREAD NORTH ACROSS THE AREA.

TOTAL SNOW ACCUMULATIONS OF 2 TO 3 INCHES WITH ISOLATED HIGHER AMOUNTS, ALONG WITH ICE ACCUMULATIONS OF UP TO AROUND ONE TENTH OF AN INCH, ARE EXPECTED.

* WHERE...THIS WILL AFFECT SOUTHWEST INDIANA, SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, WESTERN KENTUCKY AND PORTIONS OF SOUTHERN ILLINOIS EAST OF INTERSTATE 57.

* WHEN...FROM 3 PM THIS AFTERNOON TO 6 PM CST THURSDAY.

... * WHAT...HEAVY MIXED PRECIPITATION POSSIBLE.

TOTAL SNOW ACCUMULATIONS OF 2 TO 5 INCHES AND ICE ACCUMULATIONS OF AROUND ONE TENTH OF AN INCH POSSIBLE. * WHERE...PORTIONS OF SOUTHWEST INDIANA, SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, WESTERN KENTUCKY AND SOUTHERN ILLINOIS.

THE HIGHEST SNOW ACCUMULATIONS EXPECTED OVER PARTS OF SOUTHERN ILLINOIS, SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, AND PART OF THE PURCHASE AREA OF WEST KENTUCKY. LESSER AMOUNTS OF SNOW, POSSIBLY MIXED WITH ICE ARE LIKELY OVER THE SOUTHERN PENNYRILE REGION OF WEST KENTUCKY. * WHEN...FROM WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON THROUGH THURSDAY AFTERNOON. A WINTRY MIX OF PRECIPITATION WILL BE POSSIBLE DURING THE WEDNESDAY EVENING RUSH HOUR OVER THE SOUTHERN PENNYRILE AND SOUTHERN PURCHASE AREA OF WEST KENTUCKY. SNOWFALL AND MIXED PRECIPITATION WILL THEN SPREAD

ACROSS THE SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, SOUTHERN ILLINOIS AND SOUTHWEST INDIANA WEDNESDAY NIGHT AND THURSDAY MORNING.

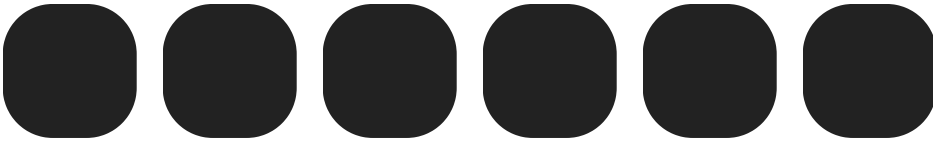
