He was driving a 2019 gray/silver Nissan frontier truck with Louisiana plate Y293967

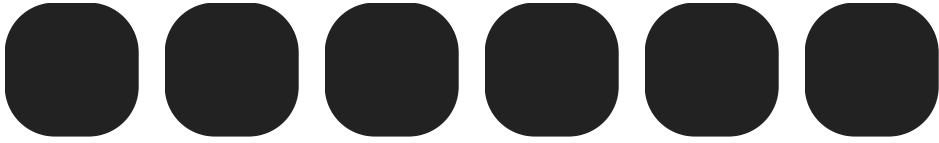

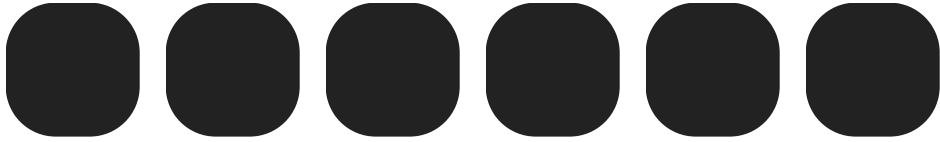
