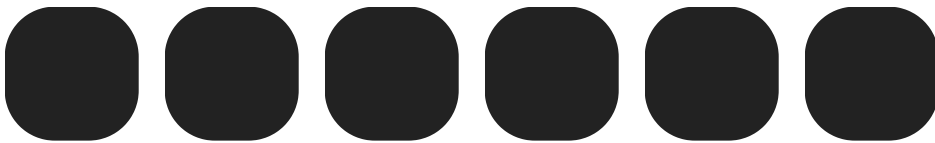

Dexter, Missouri - The Dexter School Board met on January 15, 2019 for a regular school board meeting. Below are the minutes from that meeting. The board approved a resolution calling for a special school bond election for \$15,000,000 no tax increase general obligation bond issue to be held on April 2, 2019. The board also approved the school calendar for the 2019-20 school year. The calendar will have 168 days of student

attendance at 380 minutes per day.

Minutes, January 15, 2019

1,2,3. Call to Order/Roll Call/Pledge The Board President announced the meeting is to begin, ascertains the attendance status of all board members with Mr. Herman Morse being absent. He then leads in the saying of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Amy James was approved as acting Board Secretary for the meeting.

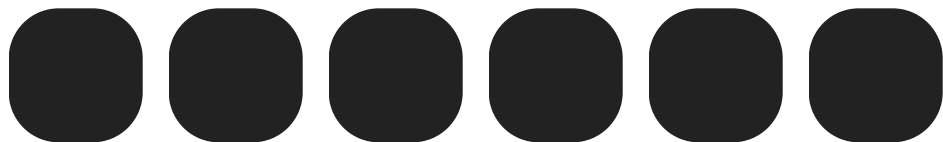

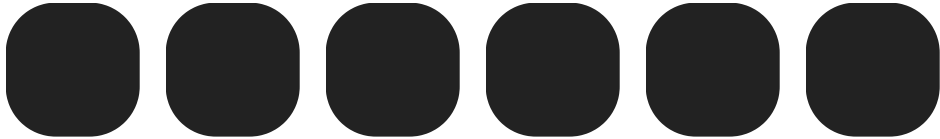
