He was married to Glenda Jean Kearbey; she preceded him in death June 21, 2018.

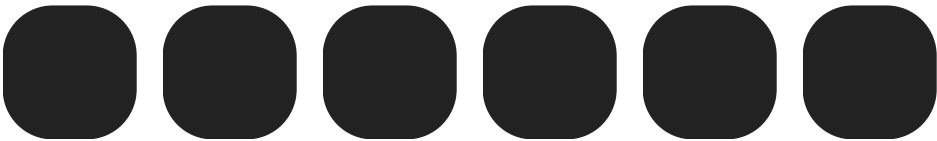

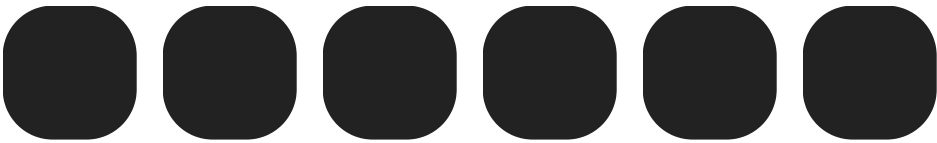
