The winners will be crowned Saturday evening April 13th at the Dexter High School prom.

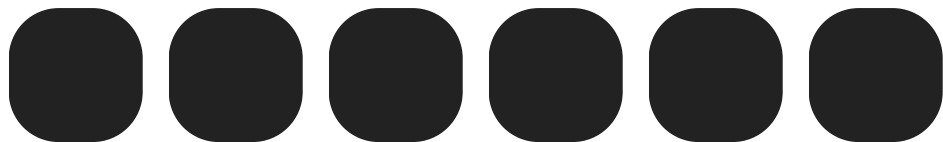
