These storms are expected to develop before sunset across western and northwestern Missouri and spread east southeastward through the night.


Given the environment, large hail and damaging winds especially will be the primary hazards with the more intense thunderstorms.

...FREEZE WARNING IN EFFECT FROM 10 PM THIS EVENING TO 9 AM CDT MONDAY

... THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A FREEZE WARNING, WHICH IS IN EFFECT FROM 10 PM THIS EVENING TO 9 AM CDT MONDAY FOR ALL OF WEST KENTUCKY, AND MOST OF SOUTHWEST INDIANA, SOUTHERN ILLINOIS, AND SOUTHEAST MISSOURI. THE FREEZE WATCH IS NO LONGER IN EFFECT.



WE WILL BE MONITORING FOR AN INCREASE IN THUNDERSTORM ACTIVITY.


