**SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT UNTIL 4PM CDT WED**

**...HEAT INDEX WILL REACH OR EXCEED 100 THIS AFTERNOON**

**... HIGH TEMPERATURES TODAY ARE FORECAST TO BE AROUND 90 DEGREES.**

**VERY HIGH HUMIDITY LEVELS WILL CONTRIBUTE TO POTENTIALLY HAZARDOUS HEAT INDICES AROUND 100 DEGREES THIS AFTERNOON. OVER SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, HEAT INDICES MAY REACH 105 DEGREES FOR A SHORT TIME, BEFORE THUNDERSTORMS BRING SOME RELIEF.**

**HEAT WILL CONTINUE TO BUILD THURSDAY INTO THE WEEKEND. AN EXCESSIVE HEAT WATCH IS IN EFFECT FOR THAT TIME PERIOD. STAY HYDRATED DURING THIS UPCOMING HEAT WAVE BY DRINKING PLENTY OF FLUIDS.**

Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service has issued an Excessive Heat Watch in effect from Thursday afternoon through Sunday evening for Stoddard County.

...EXCESSIVE HEAT WATCH REMAINS IN EFFECT FROM THURSDAY AFTERNOON THROUGH SUNDAY EVENING...

\* TEMPERATURE...MAXIMUM AFTERNOON HEAT INDEX VALUES FROM AROUND 105 TO 110 DEGREES WILL BE POSSIBLE THURSDAY THROUGH SUNDAY. \* IMPACTS...

AN INCREASED RISK OF HEAT EXHAUSTION OR HEAT STROKE TO THOSE ENGAGING IN STRENUOUS OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES.

THOSE WITHOUT AIR CONDITIONING WILL BE AT RISK.

CAR INTERIORS WILL REACH LETHAL TEMPERATURES IN A MATTER OF MINUTES.

THE EXTENDED PERIOD OF HIGH HEAT AND HUMIDITY WILL WORSEN THE EFFECTS OF HEAT STRESS, WITH LITTLE RELIEF ANTICIPATED AT NIGHT.

PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...

THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A \* FLASH FLOOD WATCH FOR PORTIONS OF SOUTHERN ILLINOIS, WESTERN KENTUCKY, AND SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, INCLUDING THE FOLLOWING AREAS, IN SOUTHERN ILLINOIS, ALEXANDER, JOHNSON, MASSAC, PULASKI, AND UNION. IN WESTERN KENTUCKY, BALLARD, CARLISLE, FULTON, GRAVES, HICKMAN, AND MCCRACKEN. 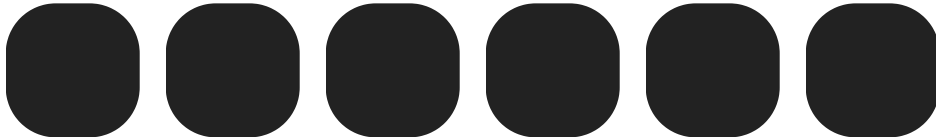
**... AT 355 PM CDT, DOPPLER RADAR WAS TRACKING STRONG THUNDERSTORMS ALONG A LINE EXTENDING FROM NEAR KELSO TO 7 MILES NORTH OF BERTRAND TO MINER TO NEAR CANALOU.**

**MOVEMENT WAS EAST AT 35 MPH. WINDS IN EXCESS OF 40 MPH WILL BE POSSIBLE WITH THESE STORMS. LOCATIONS IMPACTED INCLUDE... SIKESTON, CHARLESTON, CAIRO, MINER, MOUNDS, BARLOW, MATTHEWS, MOUND CITY, WYATT, ANNISTON, OLIVE BRANCH, HORSESHOE LAKE CONSERVATION AREA, OLMSTED, AND PULASKI.**

**SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT UNTIL 5PM CDT WED**

**...VERY HEAVY RAINFALL POSSIBLE THIS AFTERNOON**

**... SCATTERED SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS HAVE DEVELOPED THIS AFTERNOON.**

**ANY OF THESE STORMS IS CAPABLE OF PRODUCING VERY HEAVY RAINFALL.**

SOME STORMS HAVE A HISTORY OF PRODUCING 1/2 INCH OF RAIN IN AS LITTLE AS 15 MINUTES. DRAINAGE SYSTEMS CAN QUICKLY BECOME INUNDATED UNTIL THE STORM HAS PASSED.

IF YOU ARE OUT DRIVING, IN THE HEAVY DOWNPOURS, VISIBILITY WILL BE GREATLY REDUCED AND HYDROPLANING WILL BE POSSIBLE. USE CAUTION AND REDUCE YOUR SPEED.

THESE SHOWERS AND STORMS ARE PROGRESSIVE AND MOVING TO THE NORTHEAST AROUND 30 MPH.

IMPACTS DUE TO THE HEAVY RAIN SHOULD BE SHORT-LIVED. STAY AWARE OF HEAVY RAIN THIS AFTERNOON.

IF STORMS BEGIN TO REPEATEDLY MOVE OVER THE SAME AREA, WARNINGS MAY BE NEEDED THIS AFTERNOON AND EVENING.
