Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service has issued a Heat Advisory for Stoddard County, Missouri.

HEAT ADVISORY FROM 11AM CDT MON UNTIL 8PM CDT MON

...HEAT ADVISORY IN EFFECT FROM 11 AM TO 8 PM CDT MONDAY

... THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A HEAT ADVISORY, WHICH IS IN EFFECT FROM 11 AM TO 8 PM CDT MONDAY.

\* TEMPERATURE...EXPECT HEAT INDEX VALUES TO REACH 105 DEGREES AND PEAK NEAR 110 DEGREES ON MONDAY AFTERNOON INTO THE EARLY EVENING HOURS. \* IMPACTS

...THE COMBINATION OF HOT TEMPERATURES AND HIGH HUMIDITY VALUES WILL LEAD TO AN INCREASED RISK OF HEAT RELATED STRESS AND ILLNESS. THE VERY YOUNG, THE ELDERLY, THOSE WITHOUT AIR- CONDITIONING AND THOSE PARTICIPATING IN STRENUOUS OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES WILL BE THE MOST SUSCEPTIBLE. CAR INTERIORS WILL ALSO REACH LETHAL TEMPERATURES IN A MATTER OF MINUTES. PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS

... DRINK PLENTY OF FLUIDS...STAY IN AN AIR-CONDITIONED ROOM

...STAY OUT OF THE SUN

...AND CHECK UP ON RELATIVES AND NEIGHBORS.

TAKE EXTRA PRECAUTIONS

...IF YOU WORK OR SPEND TIME OUTSIDE. WHEN POSSIBLE

**...DANGEROUS HEAT AND HUMIDITY EXPECTED SUNDAY THROUGH TUESDAY**

**... MAXIMUM SUNDAY AFTERNOON HEAT INDEX VALUES SHOULD REACH 100 TO 105 DEGREES ACROSS SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, WITH READINGS AROUND 100 OVER SOUTHERN ILLINOIS, SOUTHWEST INDIANA AND WESTERN KENTUCKY. MONDAY AND TUESDAY WILL BE EVEN HOTTER, WITH HEAT INDEX VALUES FROM 105 TO 115 DEGREES MONDAY AFTERNOON, AND 100 TO 110 DEGREES TUESDAY AFTERNOON. BEING ACTIVE IN A HOT ENVIRONMENT PUTS ADDED STRESS ON THE BODY THAT COULD LEAD TO HEAT-RELATED ILLNESS.**

**VERY HIGH HUMIDITY LEVELS WILL CONTRIBUTE TO POTENTIALLY HAZARDOUS HEAT INDICES AROUND 100 DEGREES THIS AFTERNOON. OVER SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, HEAT INDICES MAY REACH 105 DEGREES FOR A SHORT TIME, BEFORE THUNDERSTORMS BRING SOME RELIEF.**

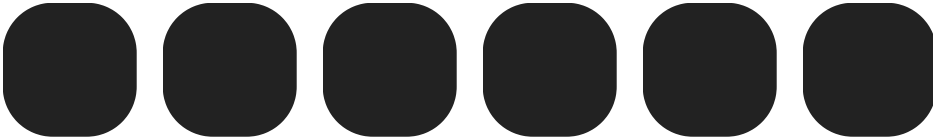

...EXCESSIVE HEAT WATCH REMAINS IN EFFECT FROM THURSDAY AFTERNOON THROUGH SUNDAY EVENING...

\* TEMPERATURE...MAXIMUM AFTERNOON HEAT INDEX VALUES FROM AROUND 105 TO 110 DEGREES WILL BE POSSIBLE THURSDAY THROUGH SUNDAY. \* IMPACTS...

AN INCREASED RISK OF HEAT EXHAUSTION OR HEAT STROKE TO THOSE ENGAGING IN STRENUOUS OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES.

THOSE WITHOUT AIR CONDITIONING WILL BE AT RISK.

CAR INTERIORS WILL REACH LETHAL TEMPERATURES IN A MATTER OF MINUTES.

THE EXTENDED PERIOD OF HIGH HEAT AND HUMIDITY WILL WORSEN THE EFFECTS OF HEAT STRESS, WITH LITTLE RELIEF ANTICIPATED AT NIGHT.

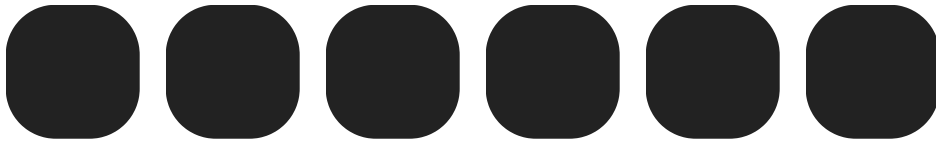

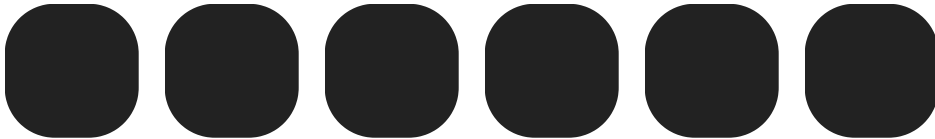

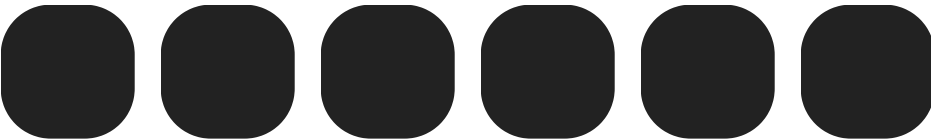

LARGE HAIL AND DAMAGING WINDS AND CONTINUOUS CLOUD TO GROUND LIGHTNING IS OCCURRING WITH THESE STORMS. MOVE INDOORS IMMEDIATELY. LIGHTNING IS ONE OF NATURE'S LEADING KILLERS. REMEMBER, IF YOU CAN HEAR THUNDER, YOU ARE CLOSE ENOUGH TO BE STRUCK BY LIGHTNING. TORRENTIAL RAINFALL IS OCCURRING WITH THESE STORMS,

AND MAY LEAD TO FLASH FLOODING. DO NOT DRIVE YOUR VEHICLE THROUGH FLOODED ROADWAYS. && HAIL...1.00IN WIND...60MPH
