In Memory of Janice Ann Camp Bacon Asberry

Janice Ann Camp Bacon Asberry, daughter of the late Samuel H. Camp and Edith Louise Alfuldis Camp, was born on September 7, 1928 in Sadorus, Illinois and departed this life on August 9, 2019 at Cypress Point Skilled Nursing in Dexter, Missouri at the age of 90 years.

Other than by her husbands and parents, she was preceded in death by her brother, Samuel K. Camp.

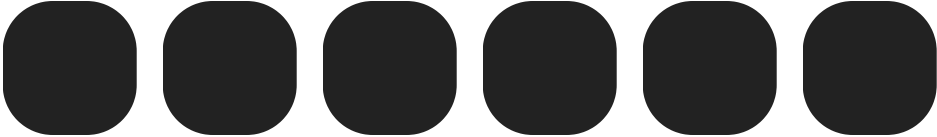
