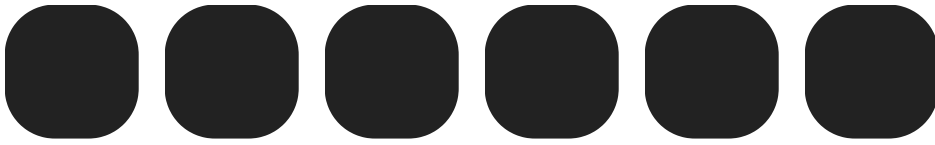

She was presented a plaque as well as a bouquet courtesy of Locust Street Flowers.

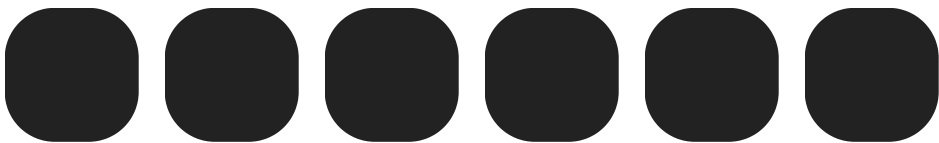

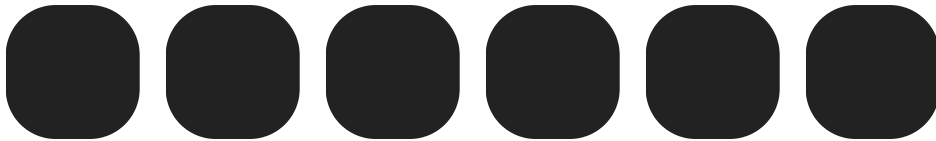
## Keller Public Library Annual Book Sale
