Maddieson (5th) is always kind to her classmates and respectful to her teachers.

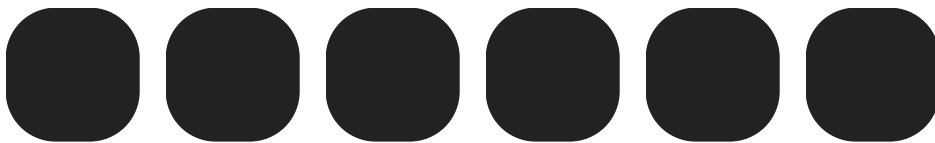
Savannah (6th) is always working hard. She also always has a great attitude.

Students will take their school pictures at this time on the stage.

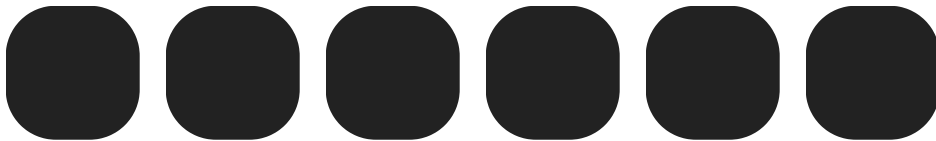
Mr. Swafford will have picture forms for you to order and asks that your student do not wear reflective neon colors for picture quality.

Bernie School Board June Meeting Minutes - McKinnis Resigns as Secondary Principal

Bernie School Board June Meeting Minutes - McKinnis Resigns as Secondary Principal

Bernie, Missouri - The Bernie School Board of Education held its regular monthly meeting on Monday, June 10, 2019.

A light agenda included acceptance of a 3-Year Financial Institution Bid from Sterling Bank of Bernie.

The Board approved the program evaluations on Federal Programs and Fiscal Management.

While addressing finances the Board approved transfer of funds from the General Fund to the Capital Projects fund as allowed for transportation and the Guaranteed Tax Base transfer, approved the final 2018/2019 Budget Amendment and adopted the 2019/2020 Bernie School Budget.

The financial statement and payment of bills were approved.

During the Executive Session, the Board accepted Lucas McKinnis' resignation as the Secondary Principal, hired Jayme Harris as the Kindergarten Teacher, and hired LaShun Rutledge as a Special Ed Elementary Paraprofessional.
