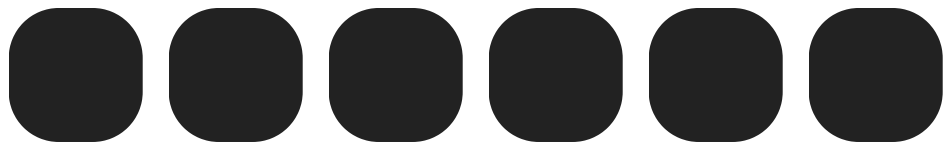

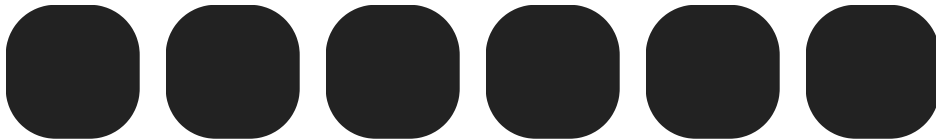

Wednesday, October 30th - Wear a Costume of Your Choice (No weapons, masks or props) Send Drugs a Scary Message!

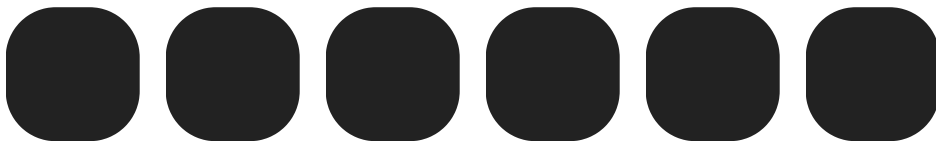
Thursday, October 31st - Wear School Colors (Mules Send a Drug Free Message)
