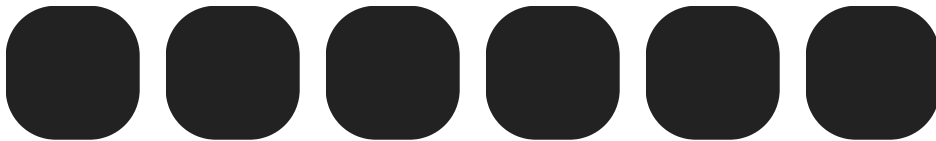

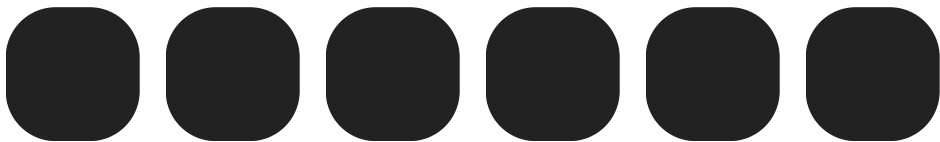

Shirley Richard, Crowley Ridge DAR Regent will introduce the guest speaker Reverend Justin Sponaule, a Gulf War Veteran.

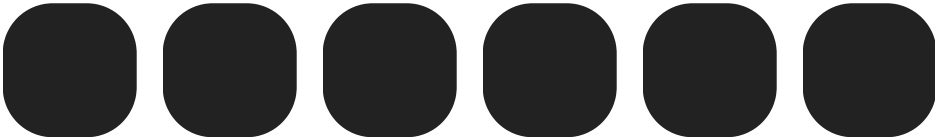
There will then be a moment of silence for the playing of TAPS.
