...LIGHT SNOWFALL AND BITTERLY COLD TEMPERATURES EARLY THIS WEEK

... RAIN IS FORECAST TO CHANGE TO SNOW ON VETERAN'S DAY.

THE CHANGE OVER WILL BE IN THE EARLY TO MID AFTERNOON ACROSS SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, SOUTHERN ILLINOIS AND SOUTHWEST INDIANA, AND BY LATE AFTERNOON INTO THE EVENING ACROSS WESTERN KENTUCKY.

MINOR ACCUMULATIONS OF SNOW UP TO 1 INCH WILL BE POSSIBLE, MAINLY ON GRASSY AND ELEVATED SURFACES.

HOW MUCH ACCUMULATES WILL DEPEND ON GROUND AND PAVEMENT TEMPERATURES ONCE THE SNOW BEGINS FALLING. FLASH FREEZING ON AREAS ROADS IS A CONCERN AS WELL, ESPECIALLY FROM AROUND SUNSET ON INTO THE EVENING, AS TEMPERATURES FALL RAPIDLY BELOW THE FREEZING MARK AND BLUSTERY WINDS GUST FROM 20 TO 30 MPH.

AFTER THE WINTRY PRECIPITATION MOVES OUT, BITTERLY COLD AIR WILL FOLLOW.

GUSTY NORTH WINDS 10 TO 20 MPH WITH GUSTS TO 30 MPH WILL DRIVE WIND CHILL TEMPERATURES DOWN INTO THE SINGLE DIGITS LATE MONDAY NIGHT AND INTO THE TUESDAY MORNING COMMUTE.

THIS WILL BE UNSEASONABLY COLD FOR MID NOVEMBER.

NORMAL LOW TEMPERATURES FOR THIS TIME OF YEAR ARE NEAR 40 DEGREES.

TEMPERATURES WILL FALL BELOW FREEZING BY MID TO LATE EVENING THURSDAY, WITH OVERNIGHT LOWS IN THE MIDDLE TO UPPER 20S. READINGS WILL REMAIN BELOW FREEZING UNTIL MID MORNING FRIDAY.

- * At 947 AM CDT, Doppler radar indicated heavy rain that will cause flooding. Radar estimates and spotter reports indicate 2 inches or better has already fallen across the warning area. An additional 1 to 1.5 inches of rainfall is expected, and this will cause more widespread flooding.

...FLASH FLOOD WATCH REMAINS IN EFFECT UNTIL 1 PM CDT THIS AFTERNOON...

THE FLASH FLOOD WATCH CONTINUES FOR * PORTIONS OF SOUTHERN ILLINOIS, WESTERN KENTUCKY, AND SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, INCLUDING THE FOLLOWING AREAS, IN SOUTHERN ILLINOIS, ALEXANDER, JOHNSON, MASSAC, POPE, PULASKI, AND UNION. IN WESTERN KENTUCKY, BALLARD, CALLOWAY, CARLISLE, FULTON, GRAVES, HICKMAN, LIVINGSTON, MARSHALL, AND MCCRACKEN. IN SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, BOLLINGER, BUTLER, CAPE GIRARDEAU, MISSISSIPPI, NEW MADRID, SCOTT, AND STODDARD. * UNTIL 1 PM CDT THIS AFTERNOON

* PERSISTENT RAINFALL THROUGH THE MORNING, COMBINED WITH SHORT PERIODS OF MORE EFFICIENT AND INTENSE RAINFALL RATES, MAY LEAD TO LOCALIZED FLASH FLOODING IN THE WATCH AREA.

* LOOK FOR GRADUAL RISES IN WATER LEVELS IN SMALL DITCHES, STREAMS, AND CREEKS THROUGH THE MIDNIGHT HOUR. MORE INTENSE RAINFALL RATES EARLY THIS MORNING WILL CAUSE MORE RAPID FLOODING OF LOW LYING AREAS AND POORLY DRAINED URBAN AREAS. ANY THUNDERSTORM DEVELOPMENT COULD WORSEN RAINFALL AMOUNTS IN ISOLATED LOCATIONS. PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...

A FLASH FLOOD WATCH MEANS THAT CONDITIONS MAY DEVELOP THAT LEAD TO FLASH FLOODING. FLASH FLOODING IS A VERY DANGEROUS SITUATION. YOU SHOULD MONITOR LATER FORECASTS AND BE PREPARED TO TAKE ACTION SHOULD FLASH FLOOD WARNINGS BE ISSUED.
