Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a Special Weather Statement for Stoddard County, Missouri until noon Tuesday, November 12, 2019.

...BITTER COLD WIND CHILLS THIS MORNING ALONG WITH SLICK ROADS

... YESTERDAY'S SNOW COMBINED WITH BITTER COLD EARLY TODAY MEANS MANY ROADS ACROSS THE REGION WILL REMAIN SLICK AND HAZARDOUS FOR THE MORNING COMMUTE.

THERE HAVE BEEN NUMEROUS CLOSINGS AND EVENT CANCELLATIONS ACROSS THE AREA.

SOME IMPROVEMENT IS EXPECTED THROUGH THE DAY. DESPITE SUB FREEZING TEMPERATURES, SUNSHINE AND TREATMENT ON SOME ROADS WILL HELP MELT AND, OR EVAPORATE THE SNOW AND ICE. WIND CHILLS THIS MORNING WILL RANGE FROM THE SINGLE DIGITS TO JUST BELOW ZERO. BY AFTERNOON, THE WINDS WILL DIMINISH.

HOWEVER, HIGHS WILL ONLY REACH THE LOWER TO UPPER 20S, WITH WIND CHILLS STILL 10 TO 20 DEGREES.

Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a Winter Weather Advisory until midnight.

...WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY IN EFFECT UNTIL MIDNIGHT CST TONIGHT...

* WHAT...SNOW. ADDITIONAL SNOW ACCUMULATIONS OF UP TO TWO INCHES. WINDS GUSTING AS HIGH AS 35 MPH.

* WHERE...PORTIONS OF WESTERN KENTUCKY AND SOUTHEAST MISSOURI.

* WHEN...UNTIL MIDNIGHT CST TONIGHT.

* IMPACTS...PLAN ON SCATTERED SLIPPERY ROAD CONDITIONS.

THE HAZARDOUS CONDITIONS COULD IMPACT THE EVENING COMMUTE.

* ADDITIONAL DETAILS...SNOW ACCUMULATION MAY BE HIGHER ON GRASSY AND ELEVATED SURFACES, AND LOWER ON AREA ROADS. HOWEVER SLICK SPOTS MAY DEVELOP AS TEMPERATURES RAPIDLY FALL. PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS... SLOW DOWN AND USE CAUTION WHILE TRAVELING.

Updated Special Weather Statement for Monday, November 11, 2019

Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has updated their Special Weather Statement for Stoddard County for Monday, November 11, 2019.

...LIGHT SNOWFALL AND BITTERLY COLD TEMPERATURES EARLY THIS WEEK

... RAIN IS FORECAST TO CHANGE TO SNOW ON VETERAN'S DAY.

THE CHANGE OVER WILL BE IN THE EARLY TO MID AFTERNOON ACROSS SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, SOUTHERN ILLINOIS AND SOUTHWEST INDIANA, AND BY LATE AFTERNOON INTO THE EVENING ACROSS WESTERN KENTUCKY.

MINOR ACCUMULATIONS OF SNOW UP TO 1 INCH WILL BE POSSIBLE, MAINLY ON GRASSY AND ELEVATED SURFACES.

HOW MUCH ACCUMULATES WILL DEPEND ON GROUND AND PAVEMENT TEMPERATURES ONCE THE SNOW BEGINS FALLING. FLASH FREEZING ON AREAS ROADS IS A CONCERN AS WELL, ESPECIALLY FROM AROUND SUNSET ON INTO THE EVENING, AS TEMPERATURES FALL RAPIDLY BELOW THE FREEZING MARK AND BLUSTERY WINDS GUST FROM 20 TO 30 MPH.

AFTER THE WINTRY PRECIPITATION MOVES OUT, BITTERLY COLD AIR WILL FOLLOW.

GUSTY NORTH WINDS 10 TO 20 MPH WITH GUSTS TO 30 MPH WILL DRIVE WIND CHILL TEMPERATURES DOWN INTO THE SINGLE DIGITS LATE MONDAY NIGHT AND INTO THE TUESDAY MORNING COMMUTE.

THIS WILL BE UNSEASONABLY COLD FOR MID NOVEMBER.

NORMAL LOW TEMPERATURES FOR THIS TIME OF YEAR ARE NEAR 40 DEGREES.

...SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT FOR SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, SOUTHERN ILLINOIS, SOUTHWEST INDIANA AND WEST KENTUCKY FOR LATE MONDAY THROUGH TUESDAY... RAIN IS FORECAST TO CHANGE TO SNOW ON VETERAN'S DAY.

THE CHANGE OVER WILL BE IN THE AFTERNOON ACROSS SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, SOUTHERN ILLINOIS AND SOUTHWEST INDIANA, AND BY EVENING ACROSS WEST KENTUCKY.

MINOR ACCUMULATIONS OF SNOW UP TO 1 INCH WILL BE POSSIBLE.

HOW MUCH ACCUMULATES WILL DEPEND ON GROUND AND PAVEMENT TEMPERATURES PRIOR TO THE ONSET OF SNOW.

FLASH FREEZING ON AREAS ROADS IS A CONCERN AS WELL, ESPECIALLY FROM AROUND SUNSET ON INTO THE EVENING, AS TEMPERATURES FALL RAPIDLY.

AFTER THE WINTRY PRECIPITATION MOVES OUT, BITTER COLD WILL FOLLOW.

GUSTY NORTH WINDS 10 TO 20 MPH WITH GUSTS TO 30 MPH WILL DRIVE WIND CHILL TEMPERATURES DOWN INTO THE SINGLE DIGITS LATE MONDAY NIGHT AND TUESDAY MORNING. THIS WILL BE UNSEASONABLY COLD FOR MID NOVEMBER. NORMAL LOW TEMPERATURES FOR THIS TIME OF YEAR ARE NEAR 40 DEGREES.

...FREEZE WATCH IN EFFECT FROM THURSDAY EVENING THROUGH FRIDAY MORNING...

THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A FREEZE WATCH, WHICH IS IN EFFECT FROM THURSDAY EVENING THROUGH FRIDAY MORNING.

TEMPERATURES WILL FALL BELOW FREEZING BY MID TO LATE EVENING THURSDAY, WITH OVERNIGHT LOWS IN THE MIDDLE TO UPPER 20S. READINGS WILL REMAIN BELOW FREEZING UNTIL MID MORNING FRIDAY.

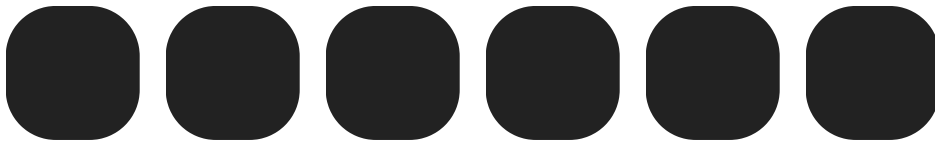
* IMPACTS...THESE TEMPERATURES WILL KILL ANY UNPROTECTED VEGETATION, AND THIS WILL LIKELY END THE GROWING SEASON. PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...

A FREEZE WATCH MEANS SUB-FREEZING TEMPERATURES ARE POSSIBLE. THESE CONDITIONS COULD KILL CROPS AND OTHER SENSITIVE VEGETATION.

* Until 345 PM CDT.

* At 947 AM CDT, Doppler radar indicated heavy rain that will cause flooding. Radar estimates and spotter reports indicate 2 inches or better has already fallen across the warning area. An additional 1 to 1.5 inches of rainfall is expected, and this will cause more widespread flooding.

* Some locations that will experience flooding include...

Cape Girardeau, Carbondale, Sikeston, Jackson, Perryville,

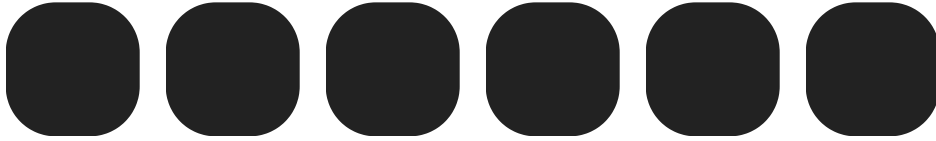

AT 453 AM CDT, DOPPLER RADAR INDICATED HEAVY RAIN THAT WILL CAUSE URBAN AND SMALL STREAM FLOODING IN THE ADVISORY AREA. ONE TO TWO INCHES OF RAIN HAS ALREADY FALLEN. ADDITIONAL RAINFALL OF ONE TO TWO INCHES IS EXPECTED OVER THE AREA.

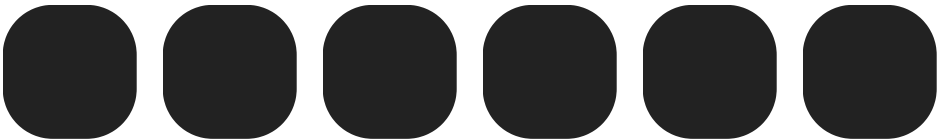
THIS ADDITIONAL RAIN WILL RESULT IN MINOR FLOODING. PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...

TURN AROUND, DON'T DROWN WHEN ENCOUNTERING FLOODED ROADS. MOST FLOOD DEATHS OCCUR IN VEHICLES. BE ESPECIALLY CAUTIOUS AT NIGHT WHEN IT IS HARDER TO RECOGNIZE THE DANGERS OF FLOODING.
