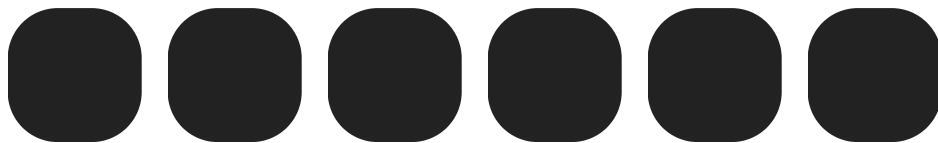
Other than by his parents, he was preceded in death by his brother, Ernest Ray Parks; and by his sister, Loretta Parks.

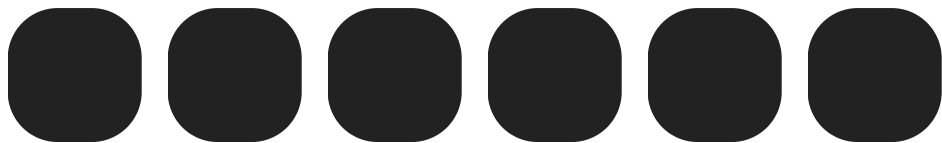

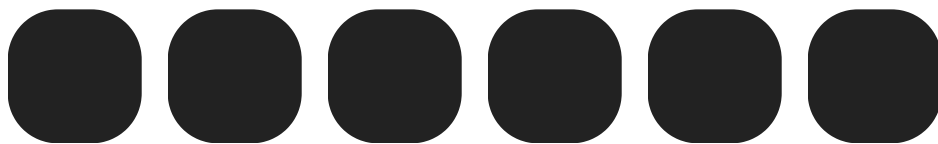
Burial will follow in the Memorial Park Cemetery in Sikeston.
