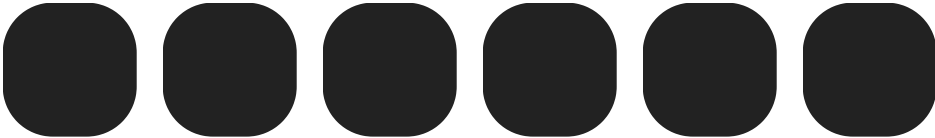
Interment will follow in the Essex Cemetery.
