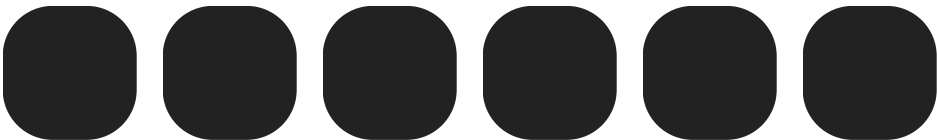

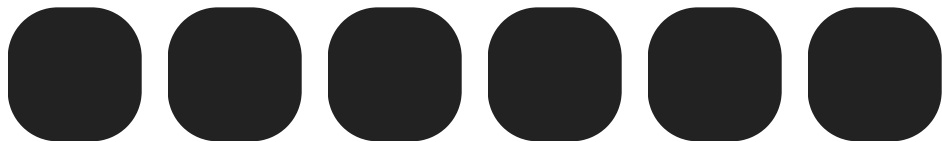

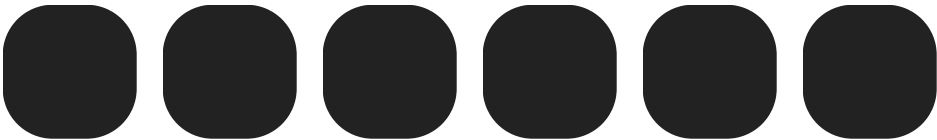

Thomas (6th) helped with a big project and had a terrific attitude.

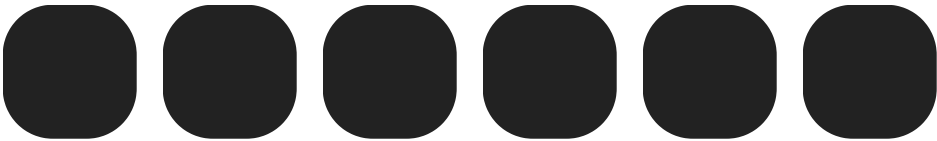
