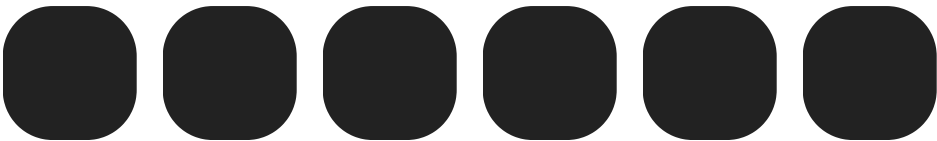

Abigail (4th) worked very hard on her MAP test.

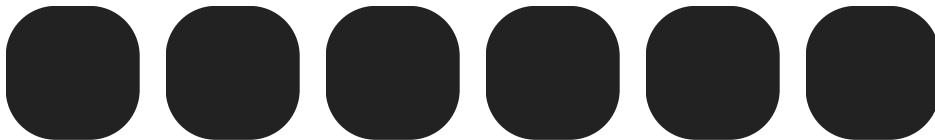

Thomas (6th) helped with a big project and had a terrific attitude.

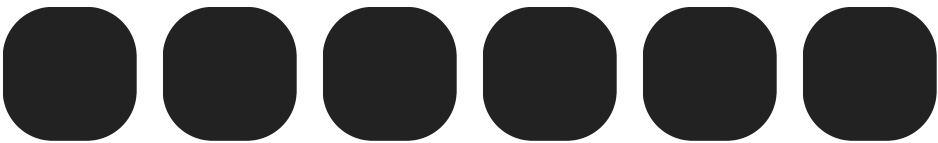
