8th Annual Prayer Walk for Dexter Schools Held on Sunday

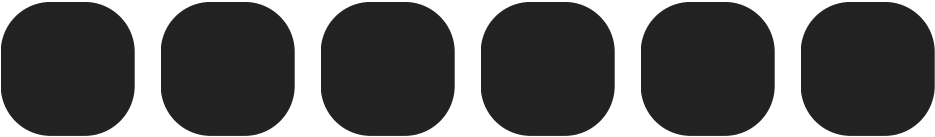
