A graveside military honors service will be conducted at the Missouri State Veterans Cemetery in Bloomfield, Missouri on

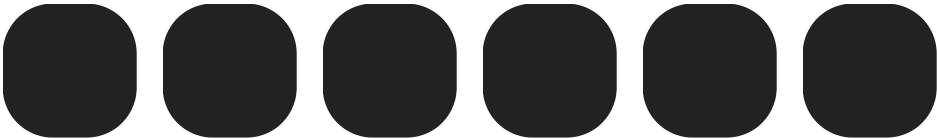

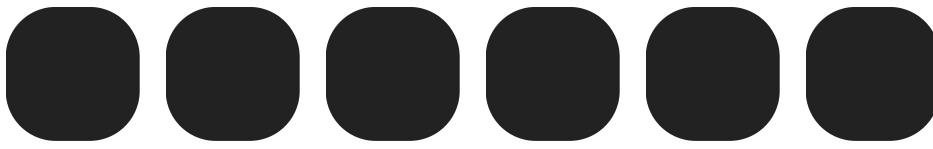

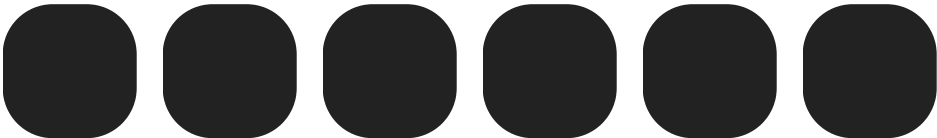
