Bernie, Van Buren, and Greenville all tied for their pool. Dexter won their pool.

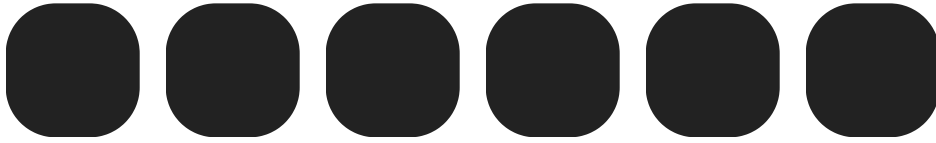

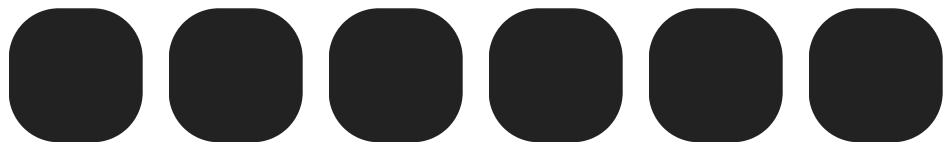

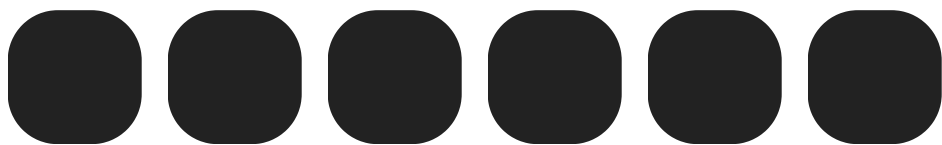
