Puxico will face Richland at 9 a.m.


Advance will play Bernie at 11:00 a.m.

Dexter had ten hits in the game. Stone, Miller, Booker, and Guethle each collected multiple hits.



Bernie, Van Buren, and Greenville all tied for their pool. Dexter won their pool.


