Visitation will be held at Mathis Funeral Home in Bernie on Monday, July 18, 2022, from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

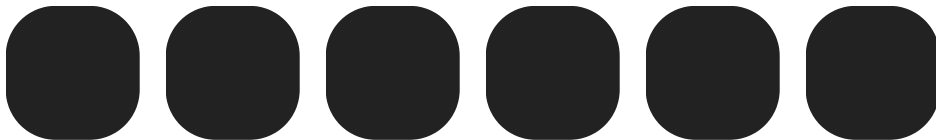
