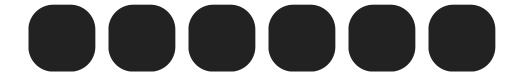
Other than by her husband and parents, she was preceded in death by her brother, Paul Dean Culbertson; and by her sister, Marlene Creg.
