Cheryl was married to the love of her life, Kenneth (Kenny) Wayne Bowling on September 6, 1970, in Bloomfield, Missouri.

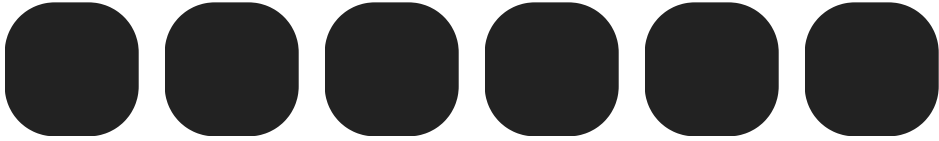
