Steven was preceded in death by his father; and one brother, Carl Raby.

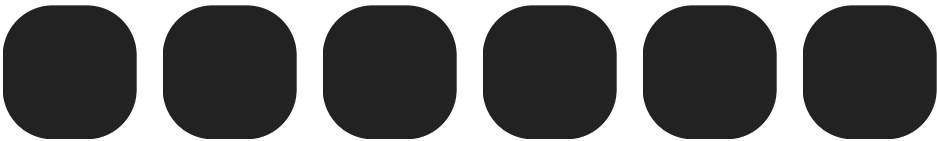

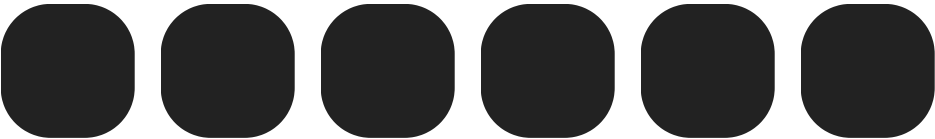
