officiating. Interment will follow in the Fairview Cemetery in rural Puxico.

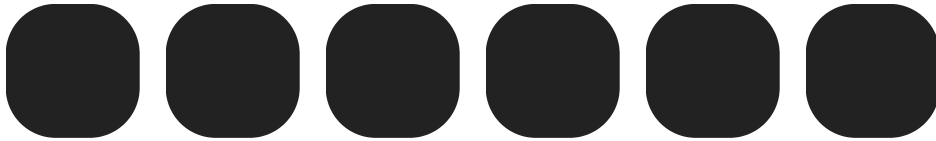
