Other than by his parents, he was preceded in death by his brother, Oral Lee Garner and by his sister, Delores Garner.

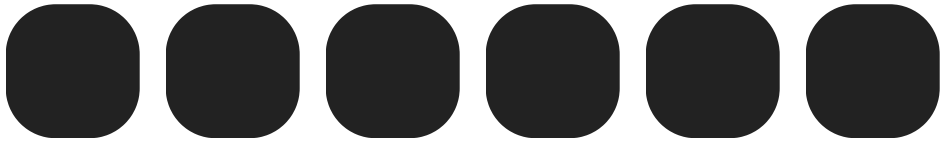
