She has been a vital part of the Marching Band and Concerts here at Puxico as well as a leader and role model in the Pep Band.

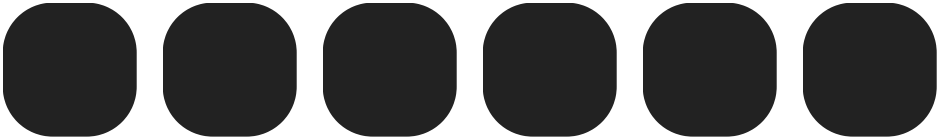
Her future plans are to attend Southeast Missouri State University - Cape Girardau and major in Music Education.

His future plans are to attend Southeast Missouri State University - Cape Girardeau and major in Psychology or Computer Programming.

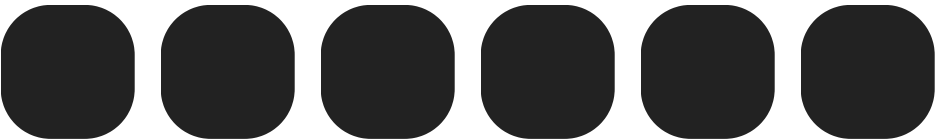
Austin would like to say thank you to his section and his friends, who made this year fun!

His future plans are to attend Southeast Missouri State University - Cape Girardeau and become a high school history teacher and basketball coach.

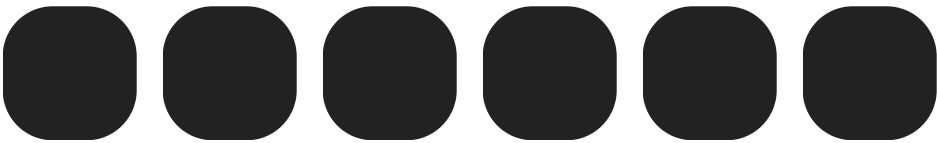

Her future plans are to attend Three Rivers College - Poplar Bluff, Missouri and further her education in nursing.

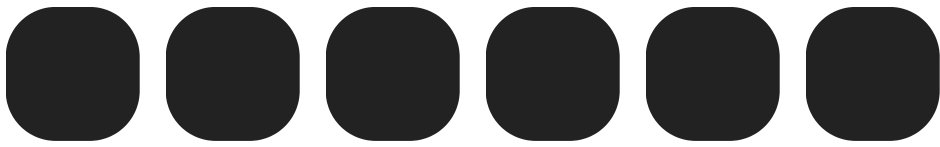

He has played for the Indians basketball team for two years while wearing the No. 33.

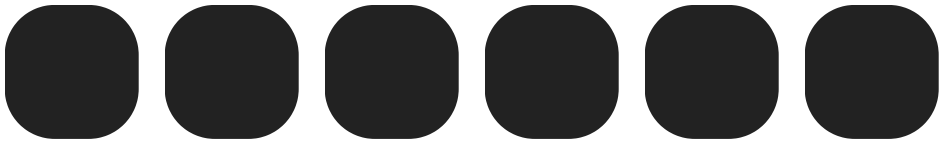
