Mrs. Powers became the elementary Curriculum Director in 2013 for two years.

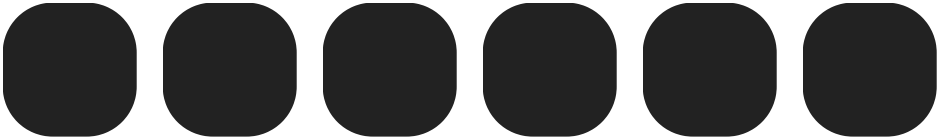
In 2014, Mrs. Powers became the Southwest Assistant Principal.

Mrs. Mouser began her teaching career at Bloomfield Public Schools in 1999 as a Speech-Language Pathologist.

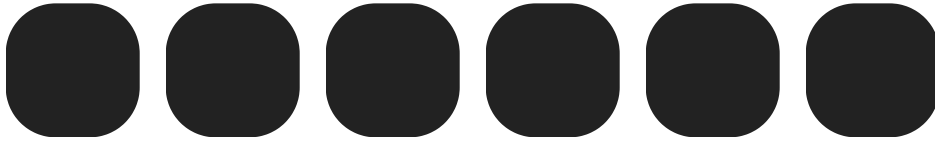
Mrs. Mouser spent 14 years at Bloomfield before coming to Dexter to continue her role as a Speech-Language Pathologist in 2013.

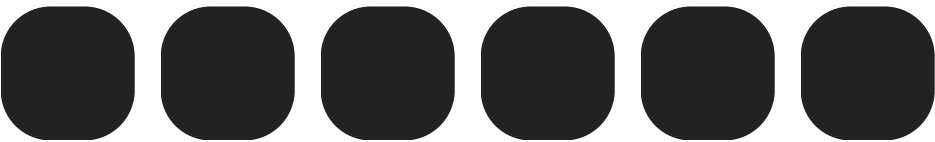
Mr. Kruse is retiring with 13 of his 28 and a half years of faithful and dedicated service to the Dexter Public Schools.
