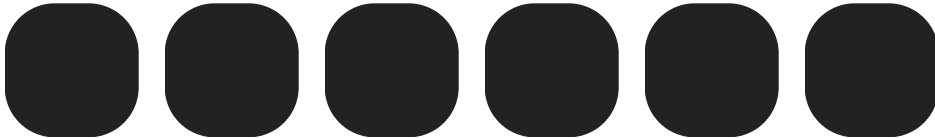

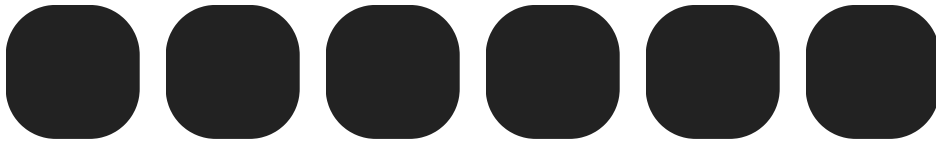

In his earlier years, he dedicated fifteen years to coaching little league baseball and donated his time as the voice of the Dexter Bearcats for over a decade. His active participation in the Dexter Lions Club for more than two decades culminated in being honored as Lion of the Year.

Serving on the Chamber Board of Directors and as a past president, he was duly recognized as Dexter's Man of the Year.

This individual harbored a deep desire for the Dexter community to have an informal gathering to inaugurate the Christmas Season.

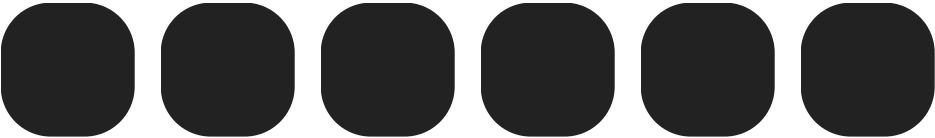
Had he been notified in advance, he undoubtedly would have attempted to redirect the award to someone else, showcasing the selflessness that characterizes this extraordinary man.
