...Hot Temperatures Through Thursday... High temperatures will peak in the mid to upper 90s each afternoon through Thursday, with a few locations possibly touching 100. While humidity levels are expected to remain relatively low by late August standards, heat index readings will still peak in the upper 90s to low 100s each afternoon. A few readings near 105 are possible today and Wednesday, mainly focused near the Perryville, Missouri to Mount Vernon, Illinois corridor. Be sure to use caution if planning to be outdoors for long stretches. Drink plenty of water, take frequent breaks, and wear light colored and loose fitting clothing.

WHAT...Dangerously hot conditions with heat index values up to 113. WHERE...Portions of southern Illinois, western Kentucky, and southeast Missouri. WHEN...Until 8 PM CDT Thursday.
IMPACTS...Heat related illnesses increase significantly during extreme heat and high humidity events. PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS... Drink plenty of fluids, stay in an air-conditioned room, stay out of the sun, and check up on relatives and neighbors.

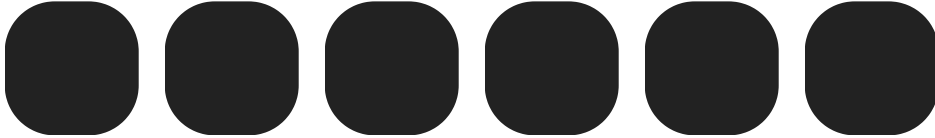
The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a Heat Advisory for Stoddard County until 8 p.m. tonight.

...HEAT ADVISORY NOW IN EFFECT FROM 11 AM THIS MORNING TO 8 PM CDT THIS EVENING... WHAT...Heat index values mainly around 105 degrees expected, but locally up to around 110 degrees is possible. WHERE...All of southeast Missouri. WHEN...From 11 AM this morning to 8 PM CDT this evening. IMPACTS...Hot temperatures and high humidity may cause heat illnesses. PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS... Drink plenty of fluids, stay in an air-conditioned room, stay out of the sun, and check up on relatives and neighbors.

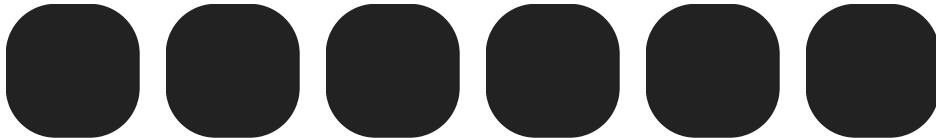
...HEAT ADVISORY NOW IN EFFECT UNTIL 8 PM CDT /9 PM EDT/ TUESDAY... WHAT...Heat index values of 105 to 110 degrees expected. WHERE...Portions of southern Illinois, southwest Indiana, western Kentucky, and southeast Missouri. WHEN...Until 8 PM CDT /9 PM EDT/ Tuesday. IMPACTS...Hot temperatures and high humidity may cause heat illnesses. PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS... Drink plenty of fluids, stay in an air-conditioned room, stay out of the sun, and check up on relatives and neighbors. Take extra precautions when outside. Wear lightweight and loose fitting clothing. Try to limit strenuous

activities to early morning or evening. Take action when you see symptoms of heat exhaustion and heat stroke. To reduce risk during outdoor work, the Occupational Safety and Health Administration recommends scheduling frequent rest breaks in shaded or air conditioned environments. Anyone overcome by heat should be moved to a cool and shaded location. Heat stroke is an emergency! Call 9 1 1.

The National Weather Service in Paducah, KY has issued a Flood Watch for Stoddard County, Missouri from Monday thru Wednesday morning.

...FLASH FLOOD WATCH IN EFFECT FROM LATE TONIGHT THROUGH WEDNESDAY MORNING... WHAT...Flash flooding caused by excessive rainfall is possible. WHERE...Portions of southern Illinois, including the following areas, Alexander, Edwards, Franklin, Gallatin, Hamilton, Hardin, Jackson, Jefferson, Johnson, Massac, Perry IL, Pope, Pulaski, Saline, Union, Wabash, Wayne IL, White and Williamson, southwest Indiana, including the following areas, Gibson, Posey and Vanderburgh, western Kentucky, including the following areas, Ballard, Carlisle, Crittenden, Fulton, Graves, Henderson, Hickman, Livingston, Marshall, McCracken and Union KY, and southeast Missouri, including the following areas, Bollinger, Butler, Cape Girardeau, Carter, Mississippi, New Madrid, Perry MO, Ripley, Scott, Stoddard and Wayne MO. WHEN...From late tonight through Wednesday morning. IMPACTS...Excessive runoff may result in flooding of rivers, creeks, streams, and other low-lying and flood-prone locations. ADDITIONAL DETAILS... - The remnants of Hurricane Beryl are forecast to move through the region late tonight into Wednesday morning. Steady rain with heavier showers and thunderstorms are expected. Parts of southeast Missouri and southern Illinois may receive 2 to 4 inches of rain and locally higher amounts are possible. Parts of western Kentucky and southwest Indiana may see heavy rain in showers and storms but the total rainfall amounts are less certain. - <http://www.weather.gov/safety/flood> PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS... You should monitor later forecasts and be prepared to take action should Flash Flood Warnings be issued.

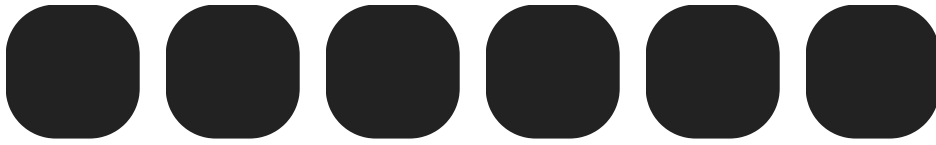
More Information

.The remnants of Hurricane Beryl are expected to move across the region Monday night through early Wednesday. Persistent and sometimes heavy rainfall is expected with parts of southeast Missouri and southwest Illinois likely to receive 2 to 4 inches of rain with locally higher amounts possible. Thunderstorms on Tuesday may also produce flash flooding across southwest Indiana and western Kentucky.

WHERE...All of southwest Indiana and west Kentucky, most of southeast Missouri, and adjacent portions of southern Illinois. WHEN...From 11 AM CDT /noon EDT/ this morning to 8 PM CDT /9 PM EDT/ this evening. IMPACTS...Hot temperatures and high humidity may cause heat illnesses. PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS... Drink plenty of fluids, stay in an air-conditioned room, stay out of the sun, and check up on relatives and neighbors. Take extra precautions when outside. Wear lightweight and loose fitting clothing. Try to limit strenuous activities to early morning or evening. Take action when you see symptoms of heat exhaustion and heat stroke.

The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a Flood Advisory for Stoddard County until 10:15 a.m. this morning.

Description

...FLOOD ADVISORY IN EFFECT UNTIL 1015 AM CDT THIS MORNING... WHAT...Flooding caused by excessive rainfall is expected. WHERE...A portion of southeast Missouri, including the following counties, Butler and Stoddard. WHEN...Until 1015 AM CDT. IMPACTS...Minor flooding

in low-lying and poor drainage areas. ADDITIONAL DETAILS... - At 540 AM CDT, Doppler radar indicated heavy rain due to thunderstorms. Minor flooding is ongoing or expected to begin shortly in the advisory area. Between 1 and 2 inches of rain have fallen. - Additional rainfall amounts up to 1 inch are expected over the area. This additional rain will result in minor flooding. - Some locations that will experience flooding include... Dexter, Bernie, Fisk and Dudley. -
