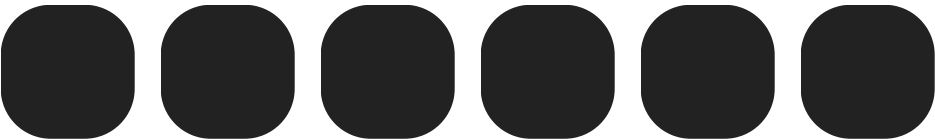
Honorary pallbearers will be Renee Watkins, Tanya Miles, Renee Lipford, and Sherry Davis.

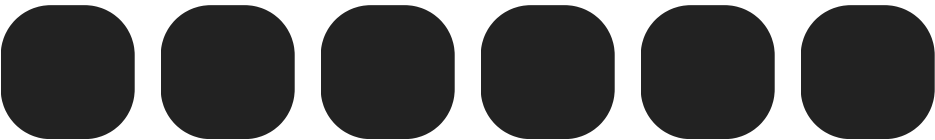

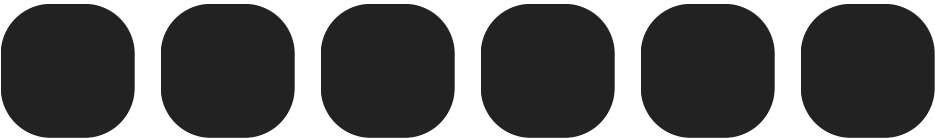
