LEGISLATIVE UPDAT

H.R. 30, the Preventing Violence Against Women by Illegal Act: Includes sexual offenses or domestic violence crimes as grounds for deportation of an illegal alien who confesses to the crime or is convicted of such offense.
PASSED. REP. SMITH VOTED YES

H.R. 28, Protection of Women and Girls in Sports Act: Ensure that no federal funds are used to operate, sponsored, or facilitated by a recipient of federal funding for any athletic competition in which biological females compete against other biological females in women's sports.
PASSED. REP. SMITH VOTED YES

H.R. 164, the POWER Act: Authorizes public electric utilities that receive assistance from FEMA for emergency power restoration in connection with a major disaster to also implement mitigation activities as part of that restoration effort. It also requires that if public electric utilities receive FEMA assistance for power restoration, such assistance cannot disqualify the utility from further hazard mitigation assistance under FEMA's Public Assistance Program.

PASSED. REP. SMITH VOTED YES

H.R. 33, the United States-Taiwan Expedited Double-Tax Relief Act: Strengthens the U.S.-Taiwan economic alliance and improves the competitive position with China by providing relief from double taxation on U.S.-Taiwan cross-border investment. The legislation was authored by Rep. Jason Smith.
PASSED. REP. SMITH VOTED YES

H.R. 153, the Post-Disaster Assistance Online Accountability Act: Requires the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) to post information on the website of the Office of Management and Budget on disaster spending.

PASSED. REP. SMITH VOTED YES
