...GUSTY SOUTHWEST WINDS TO PRODUCE ELEVATED FIRE WEATHER CONDITIONS TODAY

... GUSTY SOUTH TO SOUTHWEST WINDS WILL CONTINUE TO INCREASE ACROSS THE REGION TODAY.

WIND GUSTS FROM 30 TO 40 MPH WILL BE COMMONPLACE, ESPECIALLY LATE THIS MORNING AND THIS AFTERNOON.

HIGH-PROFILE VEHICLES TRAVELING ON EAST-WEST ORIENTED

HIGHWAYS MAY NEED TO USE A LITTLE EXTRA CAUTION.

IN ADDITION, THE GUSTY WINDS WILL COMBINE WITH DRYING CONDITIONS TO PRODUCE AN ELEVATED WILDLAND FIRE RISK ACROSS THE REGION TODAY. OUTDOOR BURNING IS STRONGLY DISCOURAGED.

**WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY FROM 3AM CDT SAT UNTIL 10AM CDT SAT**  
**...WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY IN EFFECT FROM 3 AM TO 10 AM CDT**  
**SATURDAY**

... \* WHAT...MAINLY SNOW. TOTAL SNOW ACCUMULATIONS OF ONE TO TWO INCHES EXPECTED.

\* WHERE...GENERALLY SOUTH OF A VAN BUREN MISSOURI TO MARION ILLINOIS TO SANTA CLAUSE INDIANA LINE.

\* WHEN...FROM 3 AM TO 10 AM CDT SATURDAY.

\* ADDITIONAL DETAILS...PLAN ON SLIPPERY ROAD CONDITIONS, MAINLY ON ELEVATED SURFACES, SUCH AS BRIDGES AND OVERPASSES.

EXPECT REDUCED VISIBILITIES AT TIMES IN HEAVIER SNOW BURSTS. PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS

... A WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY MEANS THAT PERIODS OF SNOW, SLEET OR FREEZING RAIN WILL CAUSE SOME TRAVEL DIFFICULTIES. EXPECT SLIPPERY ROADS AND LIMITED VISIBILITIES, AND USE CAUTION WHILE DRIVING. THE LATEST ROAD CONDITIONS FOR THE STATE YOU ARE CALLING FROM CAN BE OBTAINED BY CALLING 5 1 1.

Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a FREEZE Warning for Stoddard County, Missouri.

FREEZE WARNING FROM 1AM CDT SAT UNTIL 8AM CDT SAT

...FREEZE WARNING IN EFFECT FROM 1 AM TO 8 AM CDT SATURDAY

... THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A FREEZE WARNING, WHICH IS IN EFFECT FROM 1 AM TO 8 AM CDT SATURDAY.

\* TEMPERATURE...EXPECT TEMPERATURES TO FALL INTO THE MID 20S TO LOWER 30S, MAINLY AFTER MIDNIGHT FRIDAY NIGHT.

THE WARNING IS GENERALLY FOR LOCATIONS NORTHWEST OF THE A POPLAR BLUFF TO CAPE GIRARDEAU MISSOURI LINE.

\* IMPACTS...SUB-FREEZING TEMPERATURES AT NIGHT CAN KILL FRUIT TREES AND OTHER TENDER VEGETATION. POTTED PLANTS NORMALLY LEFT OUTDOORS SHOULD BE PROTECTED OR BROUGHT INSIDE OUT OF THE COLD.

PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS... A FREEZE WARNING MEANS SUB-FREEZING TEMPERATURES ARE IMMINENT OR HIGHLY LIKELY. THESE CONDITIONS WILL KILL CROPS AND OTHER SENSITIVE VEGETATION.

**...LIGHT WINTRY MIX POSSIBLE FRIDAY NIGHT**

**... MINOR ACCUMULATIONS OF SNOW, SLEET AND FREEZING RAIN WILL BE POSSIBLE FRIDAY NIGHT AS A STORM SYSTEM MOVES ACROSS THE**



AREA.

MOST OF THE PRECIPITATION WILL BE IN THE FORM OF RAIN EARLY FRIDAY EVENING ACROSS PORTIONS OF SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, THE SOUTHERN TIP OF ILLINOIS AND MOST OF WEST KENTUCKY, TRANSITIONING OVER TO A LIGHT WINTRY MIX LATER IN THE NIGHT AS TEMPERATURES FALL TO AROUND OR JUST BELOW FREEZING.

MINOR TRAVEL CONCERNS CANNOT BE RULED OUT, ESPECIALLY ON ELEVATED SURFACES SUCH AS BRIDGES AND OVERPASSES.

**Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a Special Weather Statement - SNOW IN THE FORECAST!!!**

**...SOME WET SNOW ACCUMULATIONS POSSIBLE FRIDAY NIGHT OVER PORTIONS OF THE FOUR STATE REGION**

**... THE POTENTIAL FOR ACCUMULATING SLEET AND WET SNOW CONTINUES FOR FRIDAY NIGHT, ESPECIALLY ALONG AND NORTH OF A LINE FROM PERRYVILLE, MISSOURI EASTWARD ACROSS THE I-64**

CORRIDOR OF SOUTHERN ILLINOIS INTO SOUTHWEST INDIANA. RAIN IS FORECAST TO CHANGE TO SLEET, AND THEN SNOW FRIDAY EVENING BEFORE MIDNIGHT.

TRAVEL MAY BE ADVERSELY IMPACTED, ESPECIALLY LATER IN THE EVENING AS TEMPERATURES FALL OFF QUICKLY TO NEAR THE FREEZING MARK ACROSS SOUTHERN ILLINOIS AND SOUTHWEST INDIANA.

FARTHER SOUTH ACROSS SOUTHEAST MISSOURI INTO MUCH OF WESTERN KENTUCKY, A COLD RAIN MAY PERSIST LONGER, BEFORE A POSSIBLE CHANGE TO SLEET AND/OR SNOW TOWARD THE END OF THE PERCEPTION LATER FRIDAY NIGHT.

AS OF NOW, LITTLE IF ANY WINTER WEATHER IMPACTS ARE ANTICIPATED IN THOSE LOCATIONS.

IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT FORECAST MODELS STILL DIFFER SIGNIFICANTLY WITH THE TRACK OF THE STORM SYSTEM FRIDAY NIGHT.

A SMALL SHIFT TO THE NORTH OR SOUTH IN THE UPCOMING DAYS COULD LEAD TO LARGE CHANGES IN THE FORECAST AT ANY GIVEN POINT ACROSS THE FOUR STATE REGION. STAY TUNED.

FREEZE WARNING FROM 12AM CDT THU UNTIL 8AM CDT THU

...FREEZE WARNING IN EFFECT FROM MIDNIGHT TONIGHT TO 8 AM CDT THURSDAY

... THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A FREEZE WARNING, WHICH IS IN EFFECT FROM MIDNIGHT TONIGHT TO 8 AM CDT THURSDAY. \* TEMPERATURE

...TEMPERATURES WILL FALL TO AROUND 30 DEGREES AROUND OR SHORTLY AFTER MIDNIGHT, THEN REMAIN NEARLY STEADY THROUGH SUNRISE. WIDESPREAD FROST IS LIKELY MUCH OF THE NIGHT.

\* IMPACTS...FRUIT TREES AND FLOWERING PLANTS COULD BE DAMAGED IF LEFT UNPROTECTED. STRAWBERRIES ARE ALSO VULNERABLE. PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS

... A FREEZE WARNING MEANS SUB-FREEZING TEMPERATURES ARE IMMINENT OR HIGHLY LIKELY. THESE CONDITIONS WILL KILL CROPS AND OTHER SENSITIVE VEGETATION.

Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service has issued a Special Weather Statement until 4:30 p.m.

## SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT UNTIL 4:30PM CDT TUE

...STRONG TO SEVERE STORMS MOVING INTO THE AREA BETWEEN 4 AND 5 PM CDT... AT 324 PM CDT, DOPPLER RADAR WAS TRACKING STRONG THUNDERSTORMS ALONG A LINE EXTENDING FROM 6 MILES NORTHEAST OF BLOOMSDALE TO 9 MILES EAST OF WEST PLAINS. MOVEMENT WAS EAST AT 75 MPH. THESE STORMS HAVE A HISTORY OF PRODUCING HAIL UP TO THE SIZE OF GOLF BALLS. SEVERAL OF THE STORMS ARE EXPECTED TO BE SEVERE AS THEY MOVE INTO SOUTHEAST MISSOURI AND SOUTHERN ILLINOIS. DAMAGING WINDS ARE ALSO POSSIBLE. LOCATIONS IMPACTED INCLUDE... CAPE GIRARDEAU, POPLAR BLUFF, MOUNT VERNON, JACKSON, CHESTER, PERRYVILLE, MURPHYSBORO, DU QUOIN, PINCKNEYVILLE, DONIPHAN, PIEDMONT, MARBLE HILL, ADVANCE, VAN BUREN, GREENVILLE IN WAYNE COUNTY, BOLLINGER MILL STATE HISTORIC SITE, LAKE WAPPAPELLO STATE PARK, SAM A. BAKER STATE PARK, MOUNT VERNON IN JEFFERSON COUNTY AND SESSER. A TORNADO WATCH REMAINS IN EFFECT UNTIL 800 PM CDT FOR SOUTH CENTRAL AND SOUTHERN ILLINOIS...AND SOUTHEASTERN MISSOURI.
