SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT UNTIL 4PM CDT WED

...HEAT INDEX VALUES AROUND 100 DEGREES THIS AFTERNOON

... HEAT INDEX VALUES WILL BEGIN TO CREEP INTO THE UPPER 90S BY 11 AM CDT ALONG THE BORDER WITH NORTHEAST ARKANSAS AND NORTHWEST TENNESSEE, EXPANDING NORTH IN SOUTHEAST MISSOURI AND WEST KENTUCKY THROUGH THE AFTERNOON.

HEAT INDEX VALUES AROUND 100 DEGREES COULD STRETCH ALONG AND SOUTH OF A LINE FROM PIEDMONT AND CAPE GIRARDEAU

MISSOURI, ONWARD TO PADUCAH AND HOPKINSVILLE KENTUCKY BY 2 PM CDT.

AS A COLD FRONT PUSHES SOUTHWARD THROUGH THE AREA, DRIER AND COOLER AIR WILL INFILTRATE THE REGION, PUSHING HEAT INDEX VALUES OVER SOUTHEAST MISSOURI AND WEST KENTUCKY BACK INTO THE LOWER 90S BY 6 PM CDT.

IF YOU MUST WORK OR ARE PLANNING OTHER OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES IN THIS HEAT AND HUMIDITY TODAY, THEN BE SURE TO KEEP HYDRATED BY DRINKING PLENTY OF WATER. TAKE FREQUENT BREAKS IN THE SHADE WHEN POSSIBLE OR SEEK AIR-CONDITIONED SHELTER, IF AVAILABLE, THIS AFTERNOON. COOLER AIR IS EXPECTED OVER THE REGION ON THURSDAY. HOWEVER, RESIDENTS IN SOUTHEAST MISSOURI MAY SEE ANOTHER ROUND OF HEAT AND HUMIDITY ONCE AGAIN LATE FRIDAY AFTERNOON.

A BAND OF STRONG TO SEVERE THUNDERSTORMS OVER SOUTH CENTRAL MISSOURI SHOULD REACH SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, ALONG A LINE FROM PERRYVILLE TO VAN BUREN BY 400 PM. THE ACTIVITY WILL CONTINUE TO MOVE EAST, SOUTHEAST 45 TO 50 MPH.

THIS BAND OF STORMS MAY PRODUCE STRONG, DAMAGING WINDS. IT WILL CONTINUE SOUTHEAST, REACHING A LINE FROM AROUND CARBONDALE ILLINOIS TO NEW MADRID MISSOURI BY 530 PM. A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WATCH IS IN EFFECT UNTIL 800 PM FOR ALL OF SOUTHEAST MISSOURI AND A SMALL PORTION OF SOUTHERN ILLINOIS.

..HOT AND HUMID CONDITIONS EXPECTED AGAIN TODAY

... HIGH TEMPERATURES IN THE LOWER 90S ARE FORECAST TODAY.

FACTOR IN THE HIGH HUMIDITY, AND IT WILL FEEL ABOUT 100

DEGREES FOR A FEW HOURS THIS AFTERNOON. THE WORST CONDITIONS ARE EXPECTED OVER WESTERN KENTUCKY AND EXTREME SOUTHEAST MISSOURI. SCATTERED SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS WILL DEVELOP THIS AFTERNOON, WHICH WILL BRING LOCALIZED RELIEF FROM THE HEAT.

SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT UNTIL 7PM CDT MON .

..HOT AND HUMID CONDITIONS EXPECTED THROUGH WEDNESDAY

... HIGH TEMPERATURES ARE FORECAST TO RANGE FROM 90 TO 95 DEGREES THROUGH MID WEEK ACROSS MUCH OF THE FOUR STATE REGION.

WITH THE HIGH HUMIDITY IN PLACE, HEAT INDEX READINGS ARE EXPECTED TO PEAK FROM 100 TO AROUND 105 EACH AFTERNOON THROUGH WEDNESDAY. THE BEST CHANCE OF EXCEEDING THE 105 MARK IS IN SOUTHEAST MISSOURI AND THE PURCHASE AREA OF WESTERN KENTUCKY.

SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS MAY PROVIDE SOME TEMPORARY RELIEF FROM THE HEAT EACH AFTERNOON.

THE COMBINATION OF HOT TEMPERATURES AND HIGH HUMIDITY WILL CREATE A SITUATION IN WHICH HEAT ILLNESSES ARE POSSIBLE.

DRINK PLENTY OF FLUIDS, TAKE FREQUENT BREAKS IN THE SHADE OR AIR-CONDITIONING, AND WEAR LIGHT WEIGHT AND LOOSE FITTING CLOTHING WHEN POSSIBLE. TRY TO RESCHEDULE STRENUOUS ACTIVITIES TO THE EARLY MORNING OR EVENING.

Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a Heat Advisory for Stoddard County, Missouri.

HEAT ADVISORY FROM 11AM CDT TUE UNTIL 6PM CDT TUE

...HEAT ADVISORY IN EFFECT FROM 11 AM THIS MORNING TO 6 PM CDT THIS EVENING...

THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A HEAT

ADVISORY, WHICH IS IN EFFECT FROM 11 AM THIS MORNING TO 6 PM CDT THIS EVENING. * TEMPERATURE...HEAT INDICES FROM 105 TO 110 ARE EXPECTED TODAY.

* IMPACTS...THE EXTREME HEAT AND HUMIDITY WILL LEAD TO AN INCREASED RISK OF HEAT RELATED STRESS AND ILLNESS. THE VERY YOUNG, THE ELDERLY, THOSE WITHOUT AIR-CONDITIONING AND THOSE PARTICIPATING IN STRENUOUS OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES WILL BE THE MOST SUSCEPTIBLE.

CAR INTERIORS WILL ALSO REACH LETHAL TEMPERATURES IN A MATTER OF MINUTES. PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...

A HEAT ADVISORY MEANS THAT A PERIOD OF HOT TEMPERATURES IS EXPECTED. THE COMBINATION OF HOT TEMPERATURES AND HIGH HUMIDITY WILL COMBINE TO CREATE A SITUATION IN WHICH HEAT ILLNESSES ARE POSSIBLE. DRINK PLENTY OF FLUIDS...

STAY IN AN AIR-CONDITIONED ROOM...STAY OUT OF THE SUN...AND CHECK UP ON RELATIVES AND NEIGHBORS. RESCHEDULE STRENUOUS ACTIVITIES TO EARLY MORNING OR EVENING. WEAR LIGHT WEIGHT AND LOOSE FITTING CLOTHING WHEN POSSIBLE AND DRINK PLENTY OF WATER. MAKE SURE OUTDOOR PETS HAVE PLENTY OF FRESH WATER. KNOW THE SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF HEAT EXHAUSTION AND HEAT STROKE. HEAT STROKE IS AN EMERGENCY...CALL 9 1 1.

Stoddard County, Missouri - A Special Weather Statement has been issued by the National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky for Stoddard County for Monday and Tuesday of this week.

SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT

...DANGEROUS HEAT AND HUMIDITY MONDAY INTO TUESDAY...

VERY OPPRESSIVE CONDITIONS ARE POSSIBLE MONDAY ACROSS

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, THE PURCHASE AREA OF KENTUCKY, AND ALONG AND WEST OF INTERSTATES 24 AND 57 IN SOUTHERN ILLINOIS.

A HEAT ADVISORY IS ALREADY IN EFFECT FOR THIS AREA. THE FORECAST FOR MONDAY IS CHALLENGING BECAUSE THERE IS MOUNTING EVIDENCE THAT SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS COULD MOVE THROUGH THE REGION LATE TONIGHT INTO MONDAY MORNING.

IF THIS OCCURS, IT COULD HOLD TEMPERATURES AND HEAT INDICES DOWN SIGNIFICANTLY OVER PORTIONS OF THE REGION. THERE IS ALSO THE POTENTIAL, IF IT DOESN'T RAIN, THAT HEAT INDICES COULD REACH WELL ABOVE 110 DEGREES.

IF CONFIDENCE INCREASES IN THE DRY FORECAST AN UPGRADE TO AN EXCESSIVE HEAT WARNING MAY BE NEEDED. MONDAY NIGHT SHOULD BE DRY AND VERY MILD. LOW TEMPERATURES ARE FORECAST TO BE IN THE UPPER 70S OVER MOST OF THE REGION, AND SOME LOCATIONS MAY NOT DROP BELOW 80.

WITH THIS QUICK START, TEMPERATURES TUESDAY COULD SOAR INTO THE MIDDLE 90S WITH HEAT INDICES OF AT LEAST 105, AND POSSIBLY 110 OR MORE, BY AFTERNOON. ANOTHER HEAT ADVISORY OR EXCESSIVE HEAT WARNING WILL LIKELY BE NEEDED FOR SOME PORTION OF THE REGION TUESDAY.

RELIEF IS ON THE WAY, AS A COLD FRONT IS FORECAST TO MOVE SOUTHEAST THROUGH THE REGION TUESDAY. SCATTERED TO NUMEROUS THUNDERSTORMS ARE EXPECTED TO DEVELOP AHEAD OF THE FRONT IN THE HEAT AND HUMIDITY OF THE AFTERNOON, SO THE WORST CONDITIONS TUESDAY MAY ONLY LAST FOR A FEW HOURS.

BEING ACTIVE IN A HOT ENVIRONMENT PUTS ADDED STRESS ON THE BODY WHICH COULD LEAD TO HEAT-RELATED ILLNESS.
